#### 10. FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT

- Engine 5531 has sustained more heat damage from the 20<sup>th</sup> Street fire in Lakeport, claim has been already filed with the State for the heat damage while the engine was on assignment. No response has been received. The Chief will send it out for repair when the fire season dies down.
- The apparatus bay door on the old station side broke and shattered the glass on the top of the door.
   New doors have been ordered and will be solid doors vs the ones with the glass. Doors will be replaced on both sides. Apparatus Bay Door #1 on the new station side is out of service with parts on order.
- The Chief reported on the Boyles Fire in Clearlake. Chief was the incident command for day two of the fire to support Chief 700.
- The Chief reported on the Harbor Fire in the Kelseyville Riviera. Aircraft response was almost immediate due to resources being in the county for the Boyles fire.
- Firefighter/Paramedic Nicki Jones has resigned from the district. Nicki expressed to the Chief how hard the decision was, but it was the right move for her family.
- Sam West will be starting his Paramedic Internship with Captain Helm in the beginning of October.
- Chief Huggins will be on vacation, out of state, starting on September 21st.
- Chief Huggins gave the revenue recap report from H.S.I







# A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL RESERVES FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE INTERGOVERNMENTAL TRANSFER PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, GOVERNMENT CODE 29130, provides that canceling reserves may be available for specific appropriation by a four-fifths vote of the Board at a noticed public hearing held as part of any regular or special meeting of which all members have had reasonable notice; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Kelseyville Fire Protection District has reserves designated for "Medical Services and Equipment" in the amount of \$1,237,473; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kelseyville Fire Protection District recognizes the need to appropriate funds from Medical Services & Equipment (IGT) reserve accounts to participate in the State Intergovernmental Transfer Program.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors of the Kelseyville Fire Protection District directs the County Auditor-Controller to cancel reserves in the sum of \$351,193 and appropriate funds for the State Intergovernmental Transfer Program according to the following:
