

# How we work

#### STUDENTS:

- We address the needs of Black K-12 students that improve student well-being and belonging in school through racial socialization, cultural education (including history and racial literacy), and events.
- Healthy self-esteem can lead to a more positive outlook and outcomes in the classroom and beyond. Our goal is to help students fully thrive.

### **PARENTS:**

- We are a supportive community filled with shared experiences and helpful resources, helping parents by addressing specific areas of need (e.g., navigating private/independent schools, building trust, advocating for students, equipping students to thrive etc.).
- We empower and encourage parents to strengthen relationships within their schools to best support students.

## PRIVATE AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS:

- We help **prospective families** actively seeking admission to schools.
- We support **families currently enrolled** in schools to thrive.
- We create an environment for **school professionals** to authentically connect with peers and families (across area schools) and provide a platform for support and information share that increases awareness and help furthering their initiatives (school-specific and collective).
- We receive **school sponsorship** to help cover hard and soft costs related to our work.
