#### **CUT COSTS ON YOUR SUMMER ENERGY BILL**

Summer rates go into effect June 1 and when the weather heats up, your energy use will likely rise, too. Here are some helpful tips and tools to help you conserve energy this summer and become a power pro!

- 1. Shift your use: When possible, use large heat-generating appliances such as washers, dryers and dishwashers outside of the on-peak hours of 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. when energy rates are the highest.
- 2.Get bill alerts: Energy Alerts are an easy way to monitor your energy use and bill before it arrives. Get weekly energy use alerts or customize your notifications for when your bill reaches a dollar amount that you set.
- 3.Keep your A/C fit: Check your air conditioner's filter every 1-2 months. Dirty filters cause your system to work harder to keep you cool, wasting energy.
- 4.Block the heat and hot air: Weatherstrip and caulk drafty doors and windows to keep the cold air in and hot air out.
