## PHONOLOGICAL PROCESSES

Phonology is a pattern of sound errors which change as children develop. Children typically stop using these patterns by the following ages:





**Devoicing** 'pick' for 'pig'



**Assimilation** 'bub' for 'bus'





Stopping 'pan' for 'fan' or 'do' for 'zoo'

**Fronting** 

'dow' for 'go' or 'sue' for 'shoe'







**Weak Syllable Deletion Cluster Reduction** 

'nana' for 'banana'

'fog' for 'frog'

**Deaffrication** 'tutu' for 'choo choo'

## **Stopping of affricates**

'tease' for 'cheese' or 'tip' for 'ship'





## **Gliding**

'white' for 'light' or 'wing' for 'ring'



**Fricative Simplification** 

'fum' for 'thumb'
