Description of Scholarship Benefits

Scholarship Eligibility and Foundation Policy

- It is the policy of the Elizabeth Firefighters Community Foundation to provide equal opportunities without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, gender, sexual preference, age or disability.
- Scholarship is open to any graduating high school student who has attended a minimum of two semesters at a high school within the Elizabeth Fire Protection District.
- Students who are related to any current member, past member, or employee of the Elizabeth Fire Protection District and/or The Elizabeth Firefighters Community Foundation, Inc. will not be eligible to apply for a scholarship award. The definition of a related party is as follows:
 - Children
 - Grandchildren
 - Niece
 - Nephew
 - Brother
 - Sister
- Students applying must fill out an Elizabeth Firefighters Community Foundation scholarship application.
- Must provide proof they have maintained at least a 2.5 or higher grade point average through high school. (An unofficial school transcript will be accepted.)

(Note: If you have not maintained a 2.5 GPA and would still like to apply, please explain why in the following paragraphs.)

Scholarship recipients must agree to provide documentation upon request, to the foundation showing that funding has been used in accordance with the scholarship guidelines and that the students Grade Point Average is being maintained at an acceptable level throughout the funding cycle.
