EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN



SUDDEN SEVERE WEATHER:

- Any sound of thunder, or sight of lightning will result in dismissal of ALL activities immediately.
- Release players and cheerleaders to their parents, guardians or caretakers.
- ALL coaches will ensure every child is accounted for and have safely left the premises.

In the event, a child's parent or guardian is not at the event location, 1 of the assigned coaches of that respective team will assume temporary guardianship and is responsible for ushering said child to safety. After achieving safe ground, that responsible coach is to notify the child's parents IMMEDIATELY, followed by notifying any board member of the executive board.

If access is available to the fieldhouse, weightroom, lockerrooms approximately 150 yards from the practice field, or WMMS Gymnasium approximately 150 yards, the entire program will seek shelter there until parents can retrieve their child.



RAIN:

- Greene Dragons Football WILL practice in rainy conditions IF the field is not completely saturated. IF rains have been steady for the majority of the day, The executive board has the power to seek an indoor location for ALL teams.
- Greene Dragons Cheer WILL not practice in rainy conditions. The executive board has the power to seek an indoor location for ALL teams.



SNOW / ICE / SLEET / TEMPS BELOW FREEZING:

- Greene Dragons Football or Cheer will not practice outdoors and will seek an indoor space.



INJURIES:

- All injuries will first be evaluated from a first aid standpoint by their coaches. If the injury seems more serious, such as a heat or cold emergency, head injury, obvious fracture or compound fracture or any life threatening medical emergency, the coach will not move the player, clear the field, have a bystander call 911 immediately and follow instructions of the 911 dispatcher.



IMPAIRED INDIVIDUALS:

- Shall any child or adult encounter any impaired individual, the child should be moved to safety with another adult, and another adult, whether that's a board member, coach or support staff should contact 911 immediately for law enforcement response. No one shall put themselves in danger to approach, or detain any impaired individual.



INDIVIDUAL WITH A WEAPON:

- If a person is seen with a weapon on their person (non threatening), no one is to approach and contact 911 immediately and contact a board member.
- If there is an active shooter, all coaches are to instruct children to run away from the assailant in a zig zag pattern to safety. Get as far away as possible!!!
