WHEREAS, the Village of Bailey's Prairie on the 14th day of May 2019, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of property or there is imminent threat of the same resulting from


ONGOING FLOODING FROM THE BRAZOS RIVER AND OYSTER CREEK

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Bailey's Prairie has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF BAILEY'S PRAIRIE:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the Village of Bailey's Prairie pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Board of Aldermen for the Village of Bailey's Prairie.
3. Pursuant to Texas Government Code section 418.108(c) this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Village Secretary and the Brazoria County Office of Emergency Management.
4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code. This declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Village Emergency Management Plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
