Griffith Spring Fest

Day 1, Tuesday 13 October

Home to Griffith

Today we depart on our holiday to the NSW Riverina town of **Griffith** for the annual **Griffith Spring Festival**. Today is a travel day, with lunch at the **Yass Soldiers Club**, and in the afternoon we pass through **Harden, Murrumburra** before arriving into Griffith.

Day 2, Wednesday 14 October

Wildlife Park and Rocking Horses

Following breakfast, we head directly to the **Altina Wildlife Park** at **Darlington Point**. This safari style park is home to a range of exotic animals. We will be given a guided tour around the park whilst travelling in style in horse-drawn or motorised carts. Late morning we leave the park to visit a farm and local identity, Libby Bailey of **Rocking Horse Restorations** in nearby **Murrumbidgee**. During a drought, Libby took up rocking horse restoration to ward off depression when all on the farm had dried up. A true example of country ingenuity! Libby will provide us with lunch and a tour of her work. From here we travel through to **Leeton**. The town is a showcase of contemporary rural Australia with many examples of Art Deco architecture, diverse agriculture and renowned country hospitality. At the **Visitors Information Centre**, we are welcomed to the town and given a **Taste of Leeton tour**. Afterwards we return to Griffith.

Day 3, Thursday 15 October

Local Gardens In Griffith

During springtime thousands of travellers' flock to Griffith to view and admire the magnificent **Citrus Sculptures**. More than 70 larger than life, 3D sculptures adorn the main street of Griffith. Created using more than 100,000 oranges, 100,000 rubber bands, a dedicated project manager and an army of volunteers these sculptures are most impressive and unique to Australia. The **Griffith Spring Fest** is celebrated during the two-week Citrus Sculpture display. Local garden owners open their homes to share their passion for gardening. We will make a stop at the **Visitors Centre** for an introduction and then enjoy some of the Garden Festival activities. We have a full day programmed including a tour of several private gardens and of course time to take in the citrus sculptures. It will be a fun spring day of colour.

Day 4, Friday 16 October

Farm Art Sculptures

From Griffith we are off to Boree Creek where we look at the "**Last Train from Boree**" sculpture that is a statue dedicated to the former deputy prime minister – Tim Fischer. The sculpture shows a likeness of Tim Fischer riding a small green steam train. Arriving in **Lockhart** there are twenty various farm art sculptures for us to look at, with several being the winning pieces of the Spirit of the Land Festival. We also visit the **Greens Gunyah Museum** and the **Doris Golder Gallery**. The portraits in this collection were created using washed wool from white and coloured sheep, no dyes were used. This afternoon we start heading back to **Griffith** and along the way we stop in **Narrandera** for some time to look through the gardens and the **Water Tower Art Mural**.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner at Hotel, lunch at Lockhart Ex Servicemans Club

Day 5, Saturday 17 October

Heading Home

After a wonderful stay in Griffith, we are ready to farewell our hosts and start the drive home. Lunch today is at the **Tumut River Brewing Co**, then we pass through Adaminaby and Cooma as we head home.

Meals: Breakfast in hotel, lunch at Tumut River Brewing Co.
