Day 1, Wednesday 5 August

Home to Sydney

Welcome to our 12-day tour to **The Kimberley**. This afternoon we transfer to the airport and board our flight to Sydney for our overnight stay before we fly out to Broome tomorrow morning.

Meals: Dinner

Day 2, Thursday 6 August

Sydney to Broome

This morning, we make our way to the airport and board our flight to Broome arriving mid-morning.

Meals: own expense

Day 3, Friday 7 August

Broome, Gibb River Road, Windjana Gorge, Tunnel Creek

Leave Broome this morning and head to the Boab Prison Tree, believed to be 1,500 years old. Continue along the Gibb River Road to **Windjana Gorge**, where ancient marine fossils lay embedded in the gorge walls and scour the banks for a glimpse of the freshwater crocodiles. Next, it's on to **Tunnel Creek**, a 750-metre-long natural tunnel carved through the Napier Range which flows through Western Australia's oldest cave system. With torch in hand, wade through the cool waters that fill the tunnel and emerge on the other side to discover a serene oasis.

Stay: Fitzroy Crossing, Fitzroy River Lodge

Day 4, Saturday 8 August	
Purnululu National Park	
Travel to Halls Creek, before arriving at Purnululu National Park. Upon arrival, check-in to your accommodation at APT’s luxury Bungle Bungle Wilderness Lodge, your home for the next two nights. The lodge boasts unrivalled access to the spectacular domes of the Bungle Bungle Range, Picaninny Creek, Echidna Chasm and Cathedral Gorge. Become immersed in the stories, history and culture of Bunuba country and its people. Take the opportunity to ask questions and connect with your guide on this intimate tour.

Day 5, Sunday 9 August	
Purnululu National Park, Piccaninny Creek, Cathedral Gorge	
Explore the magic of Purnululu for yourself and discover the depth of the Bungle Bungle Range. Walk along the Piccaninny Creek, a winding gorge with the Bungle Bungle domes. Your next stop is the natural amphitheatre of Cathedral Gorge, a spacious cavern where the acoustics are astounding. Marvel at the majestic beehive domes as your guide brings the natural history of the range to life. You may like to experience an optional scenic helicopter flight over the domes. Signature Experience - Sunset Drinks at the Bungle Bungle Range There’s no better way to end a day of discovery than by watching the sunset over the Bungle Bungle Range. With a glass of sparkling in hand, see the massive bee-hive shaped domes cast in a golden glow at this time of day. Day 6, Monday 10 August	
Echidna Chasm, Kununurra	
Today, enjoy a hike through Echidna Chasm, where you’ll walk between towering gorge wall that reach up to 200 metres in height. Afterwards, continue your journey to Kununurra.

Day 7, Tuesday 11 August	
Ord River, El Questro	
Travel to Lake Argyle and join a wildlife cruise on the mighty Ord River. Galvans Gorge, Gibb River Road

Bell Gorge	
Back on the Gibb River Road, travel to the Bell Gorge, where spectacular cliffs surround a series of tiered waterholes. Should you be feeling particularly energetic, you may take the opportunity to hike to the lower pool of the gorge and enjoy a relaxing dip below the cascading waterfall.

Day 11, Saturday 15 August	
Derby, Overnight Broome	
Travel to Derby and visit a local art gallery displaying an array of local indigenous art. Later, return to Broome, where our journey comes to an end. We have an overnight stay in Broome for we commence our flights tomorrow.

Day 12, Sunday 16 August	
Broome to Melbourne	
This morning, we are transferred to the airport and board our flight to Melbourne. On arrival, we make our way to our airport hotel for an overnight stay before our flight back to Merimbula tomorrow.

Melbourne to Home
