Day 1, Monday 28 September

Home to Mittagong

Welcome to our 3-day tour to Sydney for the matinee performance at the **Sydney Opera House** of **My Fair Lady**. Getting underway we leave the coast and head to **Goulburn** for lunch at the Goulburn Soldiers Club. Our afternoon is spent discovering the Southern Highlands historic site called **Joadja**. The town of Joadja was established in the late 1870s by the Australian Kerosene Oil and Mineral Co. Over 1300 people, men, women and children (mainly brought out from Scotland) lived in the valley. Our tour guide will take us on a fascinating historical tour of this hidden valley, full of mystery, intrigue and drama. After the historic site tour, it's time to check into our accommodation for the night in Mittagong and meet over dinner.

Day 2, Tuesday 29 September

My Fair Lady the Musical

On conclusion of the show, we head to Darling Harbour and check into our hotel.

Following breakfast, it's time to depart Sydney and begin our journey home. Mid-morning we stop at **Corbett Gardens** in the **Southern Highlands**, one of the region's oldest and most beautiful parks, it is the centrepiece of the **Spring Garden Festival** with over 75,000 massed tulips on display and 15,000 annuals. We reboard the coach and recommence our journey stopping in Canberra to enjoy some free time to look through the **Floriade Festival** and purchase lunch (passengers' own expense) before heading home later this afternoon.
