Tour Highlights

Western Sydney Airport	Torvill & Dean: The Last Dance	Old Government House

Day 1, Saturday 21 June

Home to Sydney
Welcome to our tour to Sydney to see the famous Ice Skaters – Torvill & Dean. From home we head up the Monaro Highway, through Canberra to Collector where we stop for lunch at the Olive View Café and Restaurant . This afternoon, we head to Sydney with our afternoon stop at the Western Sydney Airport . With the second airport for Sydney currently under construction and due to open in 2026, we can visit the welcome centre and get a good idea of what the completed airport will look like. From here it's not far to Olympic Park in Sydney where we check into our hotel for the next 2 nights.

Day 2, Sunday 22 June

Torvill and Dean
Following breakfast, we have a short drive to Paramatta for our morning tour of Old Government House followed by morning tea. Built by convicts, this elegant Georgian house stands in acres of parkland, overlooking the Parramatta River; and today we are guided through its history. The residence and garrison buildings were built in 1799-1816 and are the oldest surviving public buildings in Australia. Returning to Olympic Park we arrive at Qudos Bank Arena for our matinee performance of Torvill and Deans 50th anniversary Last Dance Ice Skating performance . This will be the very last chance to see the world's most famous skating superstars in action on the ice together – 50 years since they formed their incredible skating partnership. Torvill and Dean made their retirement announcement this whilst in Sarajevo to commemorate their historic Gold medal winning performance to Ravel's Bolero at the 1984 Winter Olympics – exactly 40 years to the day. While there, they relived the memories four decades on from their iconic heart-stopping performance which had a UK television audience of 24 million people and an estimated worldwide audience of hundreds of millions of viewers, on the edge of their seats. It became one of the greatest sporting moments of the 20 th Century and set a new standard for world-class figure skating. Following the performance, we return to the hotel and have dinner.

Day 3, Monday 23 June
Heading Home
We bid Sydney farewell and head south to the small town of Berry where we have our morning tea break at the Treat Factory where can also enjoy some delicious locally made chocolate. Lunch today, is in Batemans Bay and from here we return to the South Coast later in the day.
