Trustee Carpanzano is Chair of the Village's Finance Committee and also sits on the Public Safety Committee. Carpanzano is the Hospital Relationship Manager for PT Solutions Physical Therapy. He oversees the business development and community development initiatives for the entire Chicago market, which includes managing the partnership with AMITA Health and 30+ outpatient locations throughout Chicagoland. He is responsible for working directly with physicians, hospital c-suite professionals, and other key stakeholders to show how PT Solutions' remarkable patient care leads to positive outcomes, while maintaining outstanding service levels.

He was also previously the Treasurer of the Board of Crime Stoppers of Bolingbrook and also served as the Live360 Community Ambassador for The Promenade Bolingbrook. Carpanzano is a Past President of the Kiwanis Club of Bolingbrook and Romeoville. He has also served as chair of the local Young Professionals Association. In order to demonstrate his passion of giving back and mentoring the next generation of business leaders, he has sat on several marketing and strategic advisory boards such as those hosted by the United Way of Will County and Rasmussen College's School of Business.
