WHAT TO DO WHEN SOMEONE DIES

AT HOME

Including Nursing/Care/Residential Home or Hospice

When someone dies and the death is expected, the first thing is to ensure that a medical professional is willing to complete the medical cause of death certificate.

If the death occurs in a Nursing/Care Home or Hospice, the duty staff will help with the following steps

This may be via the usual GP, a Hospice Doctor or community Nurse.

Once you are given the go-ahead by the medical professional and only when you are ready, please call, or ask the duty staff to call Elkin & Bell Funerals on:

01329 600 050 (24 Hours)

We will attend the address within an hour to bring the person who has died into our care. We have a private chapel of rest at our premises.

The medical cause of death certificate is usually available the following working day. The GP or duty staff can advise you if this needs to be collected, or if it will be sent directly to the Registrar as you will need this for registration.

Please inform the medical professional if the funeral will be a cremation so that additional paperwork can also be prepared.

IN HOSPITAL

Based on procedures outlined by Queen Alexandra Hospital, Cosham

If the death is expected, you will be required to telephone QA Bereavement Services

Mon - Fri 9am - 5pm Tel: 023 9228 6175

You may not be able to speak to a bereavement officer straight away, but please leave them a message and they will return your call as soon as all the relevant paperwork is in place.

Please inform the bereavement officer if the funeral will be a cremation so that additional paperwork can also be prepared.

The bereavement officer will send the medical cause of death certificate directly to the registrar. As a death within QA Hospital occurs within the City of Portsmouth, you will need to contact the Registrar in Portsmouth (page 4)

IMPORTANT :

A Hospital Clearance (Release) Form will be issued directly to your chosen Funeral Director, so you will be required to stipulate who this will be when speaking with Bereavement Services

PLEASE NOTE :

**We will not be able to attend the hospital unless a form has been supplied.
We are only permitted to attend the hospital during their usual opening hours: Mon - Fri, 9am-4pm**



REGISTERING A DEATH

You will need to make an appointment with the registrar in the sub-district where the death occurred. The registration itself will take place over the telephone, and documents will be issued to your chosen funeral director.

DO NOT make an appointment to register until you have been told to do so by the medical professional or bereavement officer.

THE CORONER'S INVOLVEMENT

WHY DOES THE CORONER GET INVOLVED, WHAT WILL HAPPEN?

If the death is sudden, or unexpected, it is more than likely that the HM Coroner will need to be informed. The person who has died will be taken to the hospital mortuary.

If the death occurs at home, and the usual/on call doctor is not able to issue the medical cause of death certificate, it is likely that the Police will be asked to attend the address. The reason for referral to the Coroner can be because of something as simple as the person who has died has not been to visit their GP (not treating, or attending to any illness) in the past 14 days.

There will be a duty Funeral Director who is employed by HM Coroner to collect the person who has died. You do not need to worry unnecessarily if the Police are in attendance, they are also working on behalf of HM Coroner.

The Coroner's involvement doesn't necessarily mean that there will be a post mortem examination, you will be kept fully informed by the officer who will be looking after you.
