Dear Residents and Visitors,

**NSW IS STILL AT AMBER ALERT FOR COVID 19
AND ADVICE REMAINS UNCHANGED**

- **IT IS STILL STRONGLY RECOMMENDED TO WEAR A MASK IN INDOOR PUBLIC SPACES WHERE YOU CANNOT SOCIALLY DISTANCE.**
- Some restrictions will continue to apply for high-risk settings such as health, disability, and aged care.
- Schools and childcare may have their own guidance for students and parents which should be followed.

SELF-ISOLATION IS NO LONGER REQUIRED IF YOU TEST POSITIVE TO COVID-19 BUT IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED YOU STAY HOME AND TAKE STEPS TO PROTECT OTHERS.

- If you test positive on a Rapid Antigen test (RAT) please register the result with service NSW. Voluntary registration can help you access medical support from NSW Health.

PROOF OF VACCINATION IS STILL REQUIRED IN SOME SETTINGS: -

- Some premises such as high-risk settings, may still make it a condition of entry to be fully vaccinated or have a PCR or RAT test prior to attending.

Lift and common indoor areas: -

- It is still strongly recommended to wear a mask where you cannot socially distance. This includes the lift, and when unable to social distance in common indoor areas.
