FINAL INSTUCTIONS

- 1 Thank you from everyone at BLMCC for entering and supporting our event. We once again hope to bring you a fantastic day out and an enjoyable event.

Starting order is as detailed on the attached entry list. We ask that entrants arrive from 08:30 to sign on and receive their packs. A breakfast bar and a hot drink are available as part of your entry fee.

Car 1 will leave over the Bridge House Farm start ramp at 10:00, with each entrant leaving at 1 minute intervals thereafter.

- 2 **Timetable:**

08:30 Signing on opens
08:30 Breakfast begins being served in the white Marquee
09:45 Course Car Leaves
10.00 First car leaves (with all other cars leaving on minute intervals thereafter)
12:30 First car arrives at lunch halt
13:00 First car leaves lunch halt
16:00 First car arrives at finish

- 3 **Start Venue:** The event will start at Bridge House Farm and Tea Rooms, Wray. **Address:** Bridge House Farm, Wray, Lancaster LA2 8QP. **What3Words:** fishery.clarifies.anyone

- 4 **Event Packs:** Upon arrival you will be given your event pack which will contain the following:

- Monte Carlo style event rally plate (and two tie wraps)
- Tulip road book
- Car number (to place on nearside B pillar)

- 5 **Driving Standards:** A quick reminder that this event is non-competitive, and in the interests of PR we respectfully ask all entrants to drive considerately.

We ask you to consider the local residents, and as some of the roads we have used are narrow and could be busier than normal with hikers, cyclists and horses etc, please respect other road users and drive with care.

We appreciate that some entrants may wish to traverse the route at a different pace to others. Throughout the day please look out for each other and consider allowing each other by.

- 6 **Fuel:** There are few opportunities for fuel on the actual route. The route total is approximately 150 miles.

- On the approach to the start (from the M6) and after the finish:
 - Gulf, Caton - LA2 9QJ. What3Words "octagonal.warbler.koala"
- Just off route at Kirkby Stephen:
 - Total Energies – CA17 4RH. What3Words "decreased.joked.cracker"

- 7 **Route Navigation / Codeboards:** The simplest way to navigate the route is using the tulip road book provided. There is a total and trip distance given between each point. More detailed instructions are provided in the road book, or alternatively please ask anyone for assistance.

Trips can be tracked simply using the trip function on your cars instrument panel, or you can download a tripmeter app onto your phone or tablet. The best free app available for Android is

called "GPStrip 3.0", which has a green arrow with "GPS Trip 3.0" on the icon in the Google Play Store.

You will also notice we are utilising the **What3Words** app. This app divides the world into 3m squares, and each square has its own unique 3 word combination. We have used the app to provide locations for key points around the route. If you get lost from the intended route, please use these to find your way back.

For a bit of fun there will also be a number of codeboards placed out along the route, you are invited to note down as many or as few of these as you wish.

If you are unsure about the navigation please don't hesitate to contact James on **07807211829** or jamesswallow.blmcc@gmail.com prior to the event.

There will be marshals along the route, placed to keep the field spread out. You will be asked to hold back if you arrive as a cluster or within a minute of the car ahead of you.

- 8 Lunch Halt:** The dinnertime halt will be at Tan Hill Inn, Long Causeway, Richmond, DL11 6ED
What3Words: geologist.chipper.detective. Please hand in Codeboard Checksheet 1.

Food may be available at the venue but it has not been arranged so we advise you bring a packed lunch or feel free to stop elsewhere along the route. The lunch halt will be 30 minutes, however if you wish to take a longer break, or shorter, then you can do as you wish.

- 9 Finish:** Upon returning to the finish at Bridge House Farm and Tea Rooms, Wray, simply park up where instructed and make your way inside for your evening food, returning Codeboard Checksheet 2 and your signed damage declaration form.
