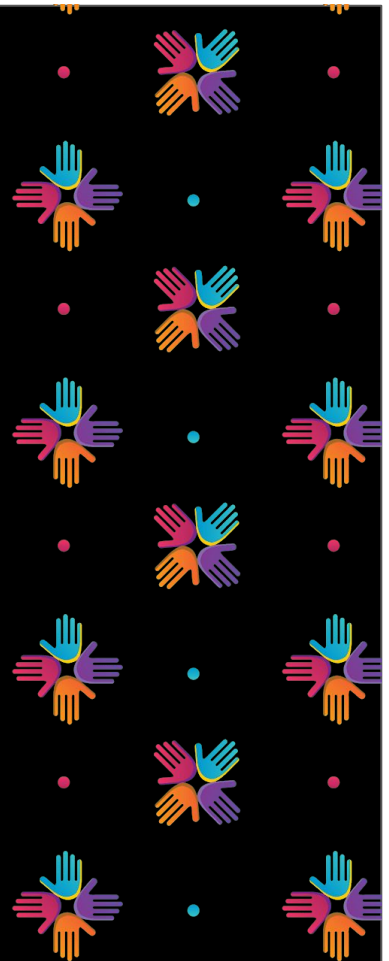
The census is a decennial count of every person living in the United States.

The census determines the allocation of federal funding for a variety of programs, including:

- CHIP
- Title IV- Foster Care
- Housing Programs
- Healthcare Centers
- Head Start
- School Breakfast & Lunch
- Adoption Assistance

WHO TO COUNT

Every person needs and deserves to be counted! Where there are more people, more funding and resources are needed.

- Everyone, regardless of immigration status counts.
- Count everyone in your home. This includes babies, relatives, roommates, and anyone else living with you — even those who aren't related to you.
- Responses are protected by law and cannot be shared with other government agencies.

Complete your census form as soon as you receive an invitation or full packet from the U.S. Census Bureau.
