



## **Admissions Policy First Month is free**

**Each resident must apply and attend an interview, if accepted be willing to follow this criteria:**

- Demonstrate Northern Nevada residency of at least three (3) months.
- Have at least thirty (30) day of unforced sobriety.
- Have a job, or seek to be employed within one month of acceptance into Hosanna Home.
- Work daytime or graveyard hours only so that she can participate in life skill building classes each evening.
- Commit to save a substantial portion of her earnings to prepare for independent living at graduation.
- Attend a Christian church service each week and a Bible Study which is offered weekly at Hosanna Home.
- Seek a General Education Degree (GED) if she has not completed high school.
- Attend training classes offered weekly in life skills (anger management, conflict resolution, health awareness; victim awareness; setting boundaries; credit and debt counseling, budgeting and goal setting).
- Attend training classes in job skills offered weekly (resume writing; interviewing; dress for success)
- Participate in monthly recreational activities (such as sports, games, crafts, cultural events, movies and community service to others) to enhance self-confidence and aid in both physical and mental well-being.

**Hosanna Home provides the following to all residents for a program fee of \$600/month:**

- Living quarters, including but not limited to: shelter, food, toiletries, and laundry facilities.
- Clothing based upon her job and recreational needs.
- Mentors who will support her in academic and personal endeavors. Personal goals will be determined by each resident and achievable steps outlined for meeting these goals.
- Personal grooming needs, such as haircuts and makeup.
- Resource direction for other needs will be available through case management assistance (Medical HAWK Clinic, transportation, education and vocation counseling through community-based programs).
- Upon graduation, Hosanna Home will match each resident's savings to help with obtaining a place to live by utilizing half of her program fees. **If a resident departs or is disqualified before graduation, no refund of program fees will be considered.**
