## 2018 GRADUATE - GRACIE

Our second graduate of 2018 spread her wings and left the nest of Hosanna Home to move into her own apartment. Gracie came to Hosanna Home in October 2017. She began working at McDonald's with the wonderful Pelton team and began to study God's word daily.

She was at Hosanna Home for two weeks and it was decided that she needed to reunite with her 18 month old, so on Oct. 27th we moved her into Leah's House. She had some very unusual occurrences—like surgery for appendicitis and several baby infections. With support and encouragement from both her family (Mom took the baby to day care every day) and us she persevered. On May 5th, graduated with a \$1500 gifting back from Hosanna Home as she personally saved a huge amount from her salary.

During her stay at Leah's House, she received a car, paid off an eviction debt, celebrated her 20th birthday and earned her GED. God continued to bless her for obedience to His Word—and a month before she left she was offered a position at the Veteran's Administration Hospital with a sizeable increase in pay. This is definitely a changed life! We are so very proud of her!







## CHANGES AT LEAH'S HOUSE

It has been a busy two years (6/2016 - 5/2018) at Leah's House. We remodeled the sixty year old house and turned it into a home for Mommies and Babies. We served twenty mothers and twenty two children during this timeframe. We provided 2241 meals and seven hundred and forty-eight nights of safety to the families that came to us.

In April 2018, our Board reviewed the finances after reductions from some donors and determined that we are unable to continue providing emergency housing for women and children. It was a noble thing to do and we helped those that came for a short period of time, however, we saw that we were not making a difference in lives long-term. Providing shelter even for three months was not sustainable and didn't really change the difficulties that the women face to care for their children as single parents.

We ask for your prayers to help us determine how best to utilize this house in the future. We are considering more transitional space for those graduating Hosanna Home but will need to review staffing and expenses.



Robbett Eyler, our Leah's House Manager, has obtained a management position and has moved into her own home. She will continue to serve at Hosanna Home as a Relief House Manager as needed.






