Summer can be a busy time for families to find time for quick healthy meals to please the whole family. This quarter our Family Activity features a fun recipe you can build as a family that is sure to please even the pickiest eaters. Creating colorful kabobs from meat and veggies on hand or letting your family pick their favorites at the store is a simple way to get everyone involved in the kitchen! Here is the directions on a delicious summer meal:

#### **Supplies**

Wooden Kabobs Your family's favorite veggies Your family's favorite meat(s) Marinade or seasoning salt (optional)

#### **Directions**

Chop meat and veggies into bite sized pieces

Toss pieces in seasoning or marinade of your choice (optional)

Allow each family member to layer their favorite meats and veggies on kabobs

Grill, bake, or cook on the stovetop in oil until meat is cooked through

\*optional marinade recipe: whisk together  $\frac{1}{3}$  cup olive oil,  $\frac{1}{3}$  cup soy sauce,  $\frac{1}{3}$  cup honey, 1 teaspoon minced garlic, salt/pepper to taste.
