Race-Day Overview

One of the best days on the racing calendar is here! Opening Weekend Fall Meet Keeneland, known as "Fall Stars Weekend", brings out serious talent and competition, and today is no different. Five stake races in a row, with several Breeder's Cup WIn-And-You're-In races dominate the card today. Not only that, but talented maidens plus allowance races also fill up the card.

The highlights of the day are the Grade 1's....three of them in a row in R8 - 10. The two turf races are absolute wars, with the First Lady and \$1.25mil. Coolmore Turf Mile contains some of our country's best. Can Carl Spackler translate his impressive Saratoga inner turf form to Keeneland?

The juveniles, featuring the fast Ferocious from the rail, will be the "meat" in between the turf sandwich. All three races are excellent and good betting opportunities.

The weather will be perfect all weekend...low 80's and sunny, fast and firm, exactly what you want on a big day. Check for scratches and changes, and be prepared to spend some money considering the field sizes and competition. All-Stakes P5 Strategy/Analysis (R6 - 10)

What a tremendous group of races....one of the best sequences of the year, including Breeder's Cup qualifications. I will be using my biggest bankroll on this set of races. The pool should be huge and payouts could be healthy, especially if #1 Ferocious loses R9. Here's my general betting strategy: I'll be spreading greatly in the first leg, a turf sprint with many possibilities. I'll go skinny in R7 and R10...that's where I'm taking a stand and planting my flag so to speak. R8 is a medium spread for me, and R9 I'll lean on Ferocious, but use many others and frankly hope to beat him. Many cheaper tickets will single Ferocious, so I'll press-up with him (as the most likely winner BY FAR if he handles two turns). The best chance for a price/value is R6.

\$3 Turf P3 Strategy/Analysis - R6, 8, and 10

As stated above, you have to spread in this leg in my opinion. There are many horses that close together in ability / speed figs, and it's just gonna depend on trip. In addition, the pace complexion is a bit tricky. There's plenty of early speed in the race, but I'm not sure it's going to favor a closer or fall apart...many are "stalking" types. There are four "Chad's" in R8 and I think two of them have the best chance to win. Tarawa is a dangerous import who should sit a great, ground-saving trip. Then, the big one...\$1.25mil. Coolmore Mile is a helluva race. This could be a battle between two of my favorite horses in training, More Than Looks and Carl Spackler. Last year's addition was a thriller. This one could be no different. I'm giving a



slight edge to #3 More Than Looks. I'll be leaning on him a bit while using several others. The big question is: will the early pace be quick enough to set up More Than Looks' wicked closing kick? I believe there are serious, potential BC Mile winners in this race. We'll find out at Del Mar next month. But for today, enjoy the race!
