### Late P5 Analysis: R6 - 10

We talk about this a lot, but a big part of this late Pick-5 sequence in terms of ticket construction is going to depend on whether you want to single one or both of the big favorites in the 8th (#6-Rhetorical) and the 9th (#8-Senza Parole). On paper, they both look really strong, so I think it is more than logical to single them both if that's the way you are leaning. As you can see above on my caveman ticket, though, I am willing to take a shot against both with at least one other horse just to see if we can't blow this thing up a little. If you are set on singling both, though, it's the kind of scenario where you can play a press ticket with the two singles and then play a smaller ticket trying to beat one or both.

The following are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1-5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

It's tough to pick a horse as a spot play who has come down with a bad case of 'seconditis' (4-of-5 in 2nd so far), but I am going to do it anyway. #3-Off Script has been a money burner losing her 1st 4 career starts as solid favorites. However, her last race after moving to the turf has given me confidence that this is her time to actually get the job done. In that race she broke way in the back, spent most of the race out of touch with the field, made a strong middle move to get into contention, got shut off multiple times in the lane, and still closed well losing a close one to a horse who came back next out to run 2nd in a NY Stallion Series Stakes with a 70 Beyer. She beat 4 others from today's field in that race as well. Now, she is 2nd on the Turf, 2nd with I. Ortiz, and is coming off a solid work so I think she is primed to run her best race.

#### Notes

Might be a bit of a pattern here with my spot plays as I am going with another horse trained by W. Walden. Hopefully, he is in for a big day. This horse, #10-Speed Shopper, came back in 2025 as a 4yo, a completely different horse especially since moving back to the Turf and stretching out to a marathon-type distance in her last. She stretched out to the same 11f distance we are at today at Saratoga and ran a Lifetime Beyer and Timeform top while rolling the field as an 8-1 shot with D. Davis aboard, who is back up for today's race. I am looking for another move forward here which would put her in the mix with the other top choices in the field. A few obstacles she will need to overcome are the move from MSW to Allowance, the outside draw, and potentially trying to close into a projected moderate pace, but I am hoping she has the talent to overcome them all.

#### Notes

This Is My Play of the Day at SAR - I hate using a short-priced horse as the play of the day, but, if we get 2-1 on #1-Fort Nelson, I see it as value. I am going with another horse moving from MSW to Allowance, but I think this one has even more talent. He had one race only as a 2yo and then was off for over 9 months before coming back in his last with a win. In that race, he was able to press the pace and wore down another W. Mott horse for Juddmonte while beating a C. Brown favorite who came back next to break his maiden with a 96 Beyer. That same type of improvement from #1-Fort Nelson here would put him head and shoulders above this field. The fact that this is only his 3rd career start means that there is definitely still a ton of upside that I am expecting him to flash here.

**#4-New Issue** is the spot play where I think I am taking the biggest leap of faith. It's not that she is some big long shot or anything, it's more about her circumstances. She is a lightly raced 3yo with only 2 career starts who has been claimed out of each. Her trainer, A. Green is still early in her career and has







only had one horse she has claimed, but that horse was a winner back in March. She is now stretching out to 8f after sprinting in her 1st 2 starts which I think will give F. Prat, who has stuck with her through each claim, to stalk and pounce while hopefully getting a little more pace to chase than she got in her 1st 2 starts. It doesn't hurt, too, that this isn't the strongest field on paper and none of the other horses are true standouts.
