## **Race-Day Overview**

Welcome to Kentucky Derby Day!! Today's card at Churchill Downs is filled with stakes, big fields, and tremendous betting opportunities. Budget accordingly, and make sure you bet your strongest opinions! The card starts at 10:30am EST and will end around 8:35pm. Today is a marathon, not a sprint. Based on the weather yesterday and potential this morning, expect the main track to start as wet/sloppy. However, it is supposed to clear up in the afternoon, and CD is known for drying up quickly. I'm expecting a fast track for the Derby (6:57pm EST), or at least listed good.

CHECK FOR SCRATCHES AND CHANGES....these might alter throughout the day, so pay attention to the tote board. In general, I'm playing a little lighter in the early part of the card and spending more money on the Pick 5 that ends in the Derby. Unless of course Friday was good to me, then I'll be firing all day! I wish you much success today...based on the big, competitive fields, you can score big if you're lucky....CRUSH YOUR BETS!!

### Howard's P5 Analysis - Races 8-12

The All-Graded Stakes Late Pick 5 that ends in the Derby is always one of the best plays of the year due to the massive pool size / equity it generates (\$5mil +?). Depending on your opinion of the Derby, you don't necessarily have to play a big ticket, but it sure does help. To complicate matters, the turf course might have some "give" in it based on the weather forecast this weekend, so I would upgrade horses that have proven form on softer turf. I believe there are some possible standouts early in the Pick 5 with Nash and Legend of Time. While they're not cinches, they are likely winners if they run their best in my opinion. I would definitely use others in the first two legs however. You could go plenty deep in R10, where I don't like the lower-priced morning line horses at all. I'll be trying to find value there. If I'm Very Busy runs to his last two, he'll be tough in the big turf race before the Derby. And in the Derby, well....you all know who I'm rooting for, but of course will use a bunch of other horses in the Run for the Roses.

#### **Notes**

I'll start my Spot Plays today with a horse that is unlikely to win, but I believe could make some noise underneath at a big price. #2 Zawish really improved towards the end of last year, albeit on turf. Trainer Helen Pitts has excellent numbers off the layoff and Hernandez knows this gal well. She's been working smartly for her return. My main theme of this race is that I don't trust the ML-faves, so I'm hoping Zawish can at least finish in the money. I like her tactical style...save ground and grab a piece in the lane. For our ROI, I'll go \$1 Place and Show.

Knicks Go, who this race is named after, was a stone-cold speed horse, and a darn good one. It's ironic then, that I love a closer in #2 Denington. I know this horse well. He's honest and wins once in a while when getting a setup, and today I think he will. I despised him last time and was fortunately correct...that was a means to an end and a total prep for this. He's 2-for-5 at Churchill and should get a wicked pace in front of him. I expect him to save ground, tip out in the lane, and have a great chance to run them down with the right trip.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT CHURCHILL!! Welcome to Round 3 of the Alva Starr v. Vahva battle. They've split the first two meetings, with Alva Starr winning last time. But I believe Irad made a crucial yet minor mistake on the turn and let Alva Starr get away a bit. That won't happen this time, and there's plenty of early speed for Vahva to track and pounce. I'm hoping to get 5-2...I'll be making a big win bet on her if she's that price. She's also been working well and is undefeated at Churchill.

#### **Notes**

The Pat Day Mile is always a fun race. And unless you believe Nash is a sure thing, this race is wide open. #7 Who Dey improved his Beyer greatly in his last effort at Keeneland, and while he was a non-threatening 2nd, he galloped out way past the winner a before they hit the first turn after the wire....he wants to go longer. Plus, there's a ton of early speed on paper, and the pace could get hot. There are no superstars in this rendition (unless Vlahos freaks again) and is ripe for a fresh face and price shots to flourish.

#### **Notes**

The American Turf is another wide-open affair unless you believe Legend of Time is a star...I'm not sure he is. Can Group got the worst of it when facing many of these at Keeneland last time. He was 4-wide first turn and 3-4 wide on the far turn. But, he kept trying and only finished 2 ½ lengths behind the winner, who returns here. There's more early pace in the race today, and his closing kick is one of the best in the field. He was excellent last year and only lost by 2 lengths in the BC Juvenile Turf. If Flavian can figure out a trip from the outside slot, which is no easy feat, he could blow up the tote board at double-digit odds. For our ROI, we'll go \$1 Win and \$3 to Place.

#### **Notes**

You knew this was coming. Our Derby Future hopeful Sierra Leone is an awesome specimen who cost \$2.3mil at the sales and has lived up to his billing. He's 3-for-4 lifetime and has been about as visually impressive as possible in the stretch. The pace in this year's Derby figures to be honest at the minimum, and he'll be flying in the lane. There are really only two questions: 1) Will Fierceness be too good and get the trip he desires? 2) Will Sierra Leone be able to weave through the field? I hope the



answers are "no" and "yes". If Sierra Leone wins, yours truly will be very happy, along with 9 other people who joined me in our podcast's Future Bet at 150-1 way back in November.
