Howard's P5 Analysis – Races 7-11

The All-Stakes Pick 5 that ends in the Oaks is not as challenging, in theory, as many of these big days could be. The reason is the presence of two likely winners / big favorites in the first two legs. How you value their chances will go a long way in determining how much money you need to spend to hit this ticket. I'm going to try harder to beat one of them, Munny's Gold, in the first leg. I'll weigh more heavily on Caravel in the 2nd leg. R9 and R10 are wide-open, while I'm focusing on only three horses in the Oaks, with back-ups just in case at bigger prices. It should be a fun sequence with great horses in every leg!

It's the first race of the day, so why not go with a bomb!? I will readily admit, this horse needs to show a LOT more than she has so far, so tread lightly. BUT, there are a few things I like that might not be so obvious at first glance. Trainer Rusty Arnold is underrated and a patient guy who develops horses slowly, and this is an aggressive spot....he knows these races on Oaks Day will be loaded with talent. She cost \$200k at auction, so she was well-meant from the get-go. There are a ton of next-out winners in her running lines...she's faced VERY good fillies up until this point, and this race is very weak for the level in my opinion. Finally, and perhaps most importantly, she's been working much better than earlier in her career and has blinkers on. Maybe she just can't run, but at a monster price, I'm throwing her in underneath in my vertical bets and betting some place and show money, which I usually don't do. For purposes of our Spot/Price Play ROI, it's a #1 Place and Show on the #3. If this horse finishes in the Top 4, I'd consider it a good opinion.

The first turf race of the day is a nice allowance affair, and I like the #1 Smokin' T. This War Front colt is starting to put it together and has a nice cozy inside post. Johnny V. takes the mount, and he figures to get a good trip. His main competition is #6 Point Me Bye, but he's no killer. If the #13 Price Talk gets into the race off the AE List, I'd downgrade Smokin' T's chances...Price Talk is the class of the field.

Munny's Gold, the #9 in this race, will be awfully tough if she runs near her best. But, there's other speed, and this is by far the toughest test she's faced. I'm very intrigued by the fact Chad Brown, who I've spoken to and is generally conservative, places this horse in such an aggressive spot on a big day instead of an N1X allowance. I don't have inside intel on this horse specifically, but I love her maidenbreaker, she's worked very well since, and Juddmonte doesn't mess around. She'll have to improve 10 points and Munny regress, but I think both are possible. I hope she breaks well, stalks on the outside, and makes a big move late. For the spot Play ROI, we'll go \$1 win on Accede and \$2 Ex. 9-8, \$1 Ex. 8-9.

Notes

This might be one of the best, most competitive races of the entire weekend. It could be a BC Distaff right now, it's that good. Classy Edition is aggressively placed here by Todd Pletcher, and the NY-bred has done nothing wrong in her first two starts of 2023, albeit much softer spots. Based on breeding, distance will be her friend, and I love her post. There's speed to her inside and outside, so I expect Irad (who will lower her price) to stalk midpack with a nice trip. She's gonna have to run the race of





her life, but some of these girls are coming off of a layoff, and I'm against #4 Secret Oath here. As you can see in my plays, I'd use Classy Edition in all spots in the trifecta plus a win/place bet, hoping to get somewhere around 6-1. We're gonna find out just how good she is today!

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT CHURCHILL!! Race 10 is a nice stake for 3yo girls on the turf. I'm looking for horses that have more upside / less starts than some of the ones that have been running throughout the winter/spring. With the presence of Irad on the #5, I'm hoping bettors will gravitate to that one more than my top choice, Revalita, the "other" Chad (have we heard that before??!!). Revalita made a huge move into a slow pace last time at speed-favoring Gulfstream on very firm and somewhat unkept turf. Today is totally different...Churchill's turf is lush and thick, and could have some moisture in it based on forecasts. She was making her stateside debut last time and broke typically slow. Jose Ortiz rode her and the filly / jock learned a lot about each other. My only concern is there does not appear to be a bunch of early speed and she has the far outside post. I'm hoping Jose tucks her in, makes a bit of an earlier move than last time, and mows them down late. I'm pretty confident she'll be the fastest in the stretch....will she get there? I hope so at around 4-1. I'll also be playing straight doubles into the Oaks: 11 / 7 BIG.... 11 / 4,6 smaller.

Kentucky Oaks quick thoughts (Howard): Please watch Ep. 254 for more details on my opinions of the Oaks, but in general, I believe this is a 3-horse race between #7 Wet Paint (top choice), #4 Southlawn (price horse), and #6 Botanical. I really don't think anyone else realistically should win. Underneath, I'm interested a bit in #13 Affirmative Lady, whom I strongly believe will love the extra distance and close hard in the stretch based on breeding. She's in great hands with Graham Motion and can run all day, plus there's plenty of early speed to set up a closing kick. I'm going 7-4-6-13 in the Oaks, good luck!!
