P5 Analysis – Races 8 – 12

Today's Late P5 feature is basically a Pick 4 IF you think Two Phils is a stone-cold single. While I'm leaning on him heavily (as are many), I don't believe he's a cinch. The first two legs are VERY difficult in my opinion and you should spread the most in those races. Race 10 and 11 are not easy either, but I'm choosing to take more of a stand. And for the Ohio Derby, it's basically a two-horse race in my opinion with Two Phils vs. Bishops Bay...I'd be very surprised if anyone else wins.

How can you not go with a horse whose name is "Hoppy Gilmore"? In all seriousness though, this trainer is amazing off long layoffs in the last 5 years, hitting at almost 30% and 44% in the money. They've pointed here, has been working well, and should get some pace to close into. If he's ready off the layoff, he's got as good a chance as any....a come-from-behind victory is very possible.

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Ohio-breds going 1 1/8 miles for a big purse. Pedigree plays a big part in these races due to the distance IMO. Therefore, I'm going with a horse partially-owned by WinStar Farm that appears will love the distance, #2 Fair and Square. This colt by Super Saver has a dam in Marathon (gotta like distance with that name, right?) whose the daughter of Drosselmeyer, who could run all day and won the BC Classic. But it's not just pedigree alone....He's never been out of the money, gets a ground-saving post from the 2-hole, and can close (I think) if necessary while being tactical early. His last race was a bit disappointing, but was on turf, and also gave him 2-turn experience which is very important. Would like to see a stalk and pounce winning effort today.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT THISTLEDOWNS!! This race for the girls going two turns has a lot of speed lined up, especially on the outside. It sure looks like the pace has to be honest. Le Da Vida is not exactly a win machine, having lost her last 5 starts. But when you look closely, many of those have been with slow paces, and this gal comes from behind. If she gets the anticipated pace set up, I think she's the best closer. The jock knows her best, and I'm expecting her to be FLYING in the lane. She does need to be on the correct lead, as last time she was hanging on her left lead. Look for her to at least be in the money, I'm hoping 1st or 2nd at worst.

P5 Analysis – Races 6 – 10

The Pick 4 at Ellis is interesting, with some potential prices spread throughout the races. Race 9, the Chicago S., seems to be a 2 or at most 3-horse affair, so that will allow you to spread elsewhere. I'm taking a stand with the 7 in the last, despite the fact MANY can win in there....it's a tough way to close the Late P4 for sure! The biggest spread for me comes in R8, an impossible allowance on the turf. Unless the #4 handles the turf, almost anyone in there can win.

Use him in all spots in your trifecta...I'm hoping he at least is the money.

He was professional on the inside, tipped out, and made a big run, just losing to the very well-meant Zartownis for Cherie DeVaux at 30c to the dollar at Horseshoe. He has a bullet work since at the Churchill Downs Training Track, and Emigh retains the ride. Contention runs deep, so he'll have to improve, but he has a big shot where many are going to spread in their horizontals.
