International Racing Tip Sheet
November 5th-9th, 2025
Flemington, Rosehill, Munich, Doncaster, Saint Cloud

The **Melbourne Spring** is full effect and it's **Oaks Day at Flemington** on Thursday (beginning Wednesday night, a few hours from now on the East Coast) and then there are three **Gr1s on Champions Day on Saturday**, as well as few juicy Group races at Rosehill in Sydney, with the Magic Man Moreira in town, fresh from his win in the Brazilian Derby at Gavea in Rio de Janeiro two weeks ago. There is a nice Listed race at Lyon in on Friday afternoon (early morning USA time). The last Group 1 in Europe goes at Munich on Saturday, as well a couple of races at Doncaster as the UK flat season winds down. And to close the weekend, there are a couple of nice races Listed races at Saint Cloud in France.

It has been a difficult year health wise for me. I appreciate the patience of those who followed this year. I hope there are more than a few winners here. There will just be one more international tip sheet this year on the weekend on the Hong Kong International Races in December.

Thursday

Flemington

R5 11:20 pm Wednesday Listed Chester Manifold Stakes

10 (3) Enxuto 3/1 Fav

Enxuto finished 3rd on Derby Day (yes, five days ago, a not unusual turn around for horse during big Australian meets) and would have won, but for the door closing in the final furlong. The horse will probably go off shorter than 3/1 given that performance.

3 (1) Apulia 8/1

Apulia returned after a year off from injury to win over 7 1/2 furlongs going from last to first in a blink on Cox Plate day. The horse is a middle distance horse, so this Mile is still short of his best distance, but he'll be closing and it's advisable to play him in way you can, including exotics with Enxuto.

R6 11:55 pm EST (Wednesday) Country Championship Final

6 (7) Guerite 8/1

I have watched film of this horse finishing like Frankel with a motionless jockey. 8/1 seems like a socialist, square price (though my knowledge of the country tracks is limited). Suffice to say if the horse is closer 4s as they're going to post, it's probably a bet. I am taken the price already.

R7 00:30 am EST Thursday
Gr3 Crown Red Roses Stakes, 5 1/2 F

7 (18) Point Barrow 3/1

A sprint down the stretch at Flemington and wide is where you need to be. Point Barrow is a swooper and the extra 1/2 Furlong and wide draw works perfectly for him. McDonald is up on the Waller horse, Surf's Up is a threat, but is drawn (2).

R8 01:10 am EST (Thursday)
Gr1 Crown Oaks

The Danny O'Brien Fav is way too short at 4/5 and it's a bit of a no brainer to take the 6/1 on the Sydney shipper for Chris Waller. McDonald takes the ride. She was no match for the boys last time in the Gr1 Moët and Chandon Spring Champion Stakes last time at Randwick, despite finishing 3rd. This might be easier against her own sex.

1 (4) Casapueblo S/P

The globe trotting Gr1 stayer Irisine will be a hot Fav for this, but he is an 8yr old looking for easy money in the provinces and I am taking him on with Casapueblo, an improving Andre Fabre 4 yr in the Godolphin silks. He may have finished last time but he ran into the buzzsaw that is Convergent (more on him later) in very competitive Gr2 at Longchamp last month and there wasn't much between the bunch that finished behind the front three.

Saturday

Flemington

R2 09:15 pm Friday, 1 Mile

2 (13) Sabaj 8/5 Fav

The horse was withdrawn last weekend with this the preference. I tipped the horse last month, but the former South Australia galloper needed the race. This is no Linebacker is this race.

R5 11:10 am EST
Gr3 Queen Elizabeth Stakes, 1M 5F

1 (12) Birdman 9/2

The Chis Waller stayer skipped the Melbourne Cup for this. He is top weight and deservedly so, after running 6th to Caulfield Cup and Melbourne Cup winner, Half Yours. Sayedaty Sedaty who won the Bendigo Cup last week is a threat. The quinella is the bet.

R6 11:50 pm EST Friday
Gr1 VRC Champions Sprint

10 (3) Tentyris 8/5

I encourage to look for Tentyris' jailbreak win last time on the Twitter X platform. I tipped the horse on these pages for a win before and this maybe the best 3 yr old Sprinter in the world. This is no shoe with Joliestar returning from her courageous 5th place in the Everest, but Tentyris seems special and look for him at Royal Ascot next Summer.

R7 00:30 am Saturday
VRC Championship Mile

9 (3) Treasurethe Moment 6/1

Treasurethe Moment cuts back 2 furlongs from the Gr1 Cox Plate where she almost clung on. The horse won the Australian Oaks last season and was the greatest thing since sliced bread in Australia destroying her opponents over a range of distances, until a mild bout of colic hampered her season. She won over a Mile at Flemington last season. You'll get a price because there is a lot of good horses here including Ceowulf, winner of the Gr1 King Charles III, as well as Pride of Jenni and Mr Brightside and British raider Lake Forest with Tom Marquand jetting in for the ride. It maybe my MO to follow the jockey, but Lake Forest is not a horse I can play with any confidence. Yulong's Treasurethe Moment has entries in Hong Kong in December, as does similarly rated Stefi Magnetica, but I am siding with Damian Lane here.

R8 01:10 am EST
Gr1 Champions Stakes, 10 F

10 (10) Via Sistana is the odds on 8/11 Fav, but her win in the Cox Plate was a gut buster and there could be value elsewhere. My advice would be to include 2 (3) Light Infantry Man 8/1 and 3 (2) Kocalica 16/1 in place plays and exotics.

Rosehill

João "Magic Man" Moreira has 6 rides at Chris Waller's local track I. Sydney. I like 2 in particular. 3 or the other 4 are big prices including Pounce, last seen racing at Gulfstream Park in the Gr3 Honey Fox. It seems feasible that despite their big prices and negatives such as being first up, etc that Moreira will boot home one of the longer prices, so keep a market watch on R4 Just Too Fly 11/1, R5 Existential Bob 20/1, R6 Jaipur Mason 28/1 and R7 Pounce 16/1. I am inclined to play Existential Bob at 20/1 who may need further, but maps to get a cosy run from the 3 hole. Moreira could be the difference.

R8 00:50 am EST Saturday
Listed 5 Diamonds, 9F

7 (11) Militarize 7/1

British trainer William Haggas ships in with Bullet Point who was last finishing 7th Strensall Stakes at York in August, but has earlier finished 2nd in the Royal Hunt Cup at Royal Ascot and 2nd in a prestigious handicap at York. The horse needs firm and gets firm at Rosehill. Jockey Cieran Fallon flies in from the UK. This is a 2 Million Aussie Dollar race hence the attraction. However, I am siding with the inconsistent Militarize who impressed me last time when a closing fast second to Linderman. The horse wins when the big money is down and Moreira is booked for a reason. This is the one he is here for. The horse also has multiple entries in Hong Kong in December.

9 (1) Frosty Girl Ev

The hot Fav, highly touted Waller horse with the Magic Man up. Looks like a penalty kick, the most likely winner on the day.

Munich

Convergent was a hard luck runner in the German Derby, but rebounded to win the Gr2 Prix Conseil Paris ago against older horses at Longchamp last month. French raider Junko (winner of the Hong Kong Vase two years ago) for Andre Fabre and British raider Ball City Roller were close by in that Longchamp race. Their presence along with local Alleno (winner of a Gr2 last time at Cologne) as well as Brazilian Gr1 winner Cold Heart should ensure you get a fair price. **Anything above Evens is huge value and worth betting hard.** Regular rider Clifford Lee was injured in a bike accident recently and won't be riding.

Doncaster

The declarations have not been made yet, but there are a couple of horses I like.

R3 08:25 am EST
Listed Wentworth Stakes

Vadream returned to form last time finishing 5th at Newmarket and that was over firm in early October. The horse thrives on soft going and is great value at 33/1. **Circe** is currently 16/1 and also represents value, if declared.

R6 10:10 am EST
Listed Gillies Fillies Stakes, 10F

This seems perfect for Daniele 5/2 Fav who is often a bridesmaid for John Gosden, but I like the Owen Burrows filly Azaniya 5/1 who just kept running in a listed affair over 10 furlongs in super soft conditions at Compiègne. She won earlier in the year in a lowly class 4 at Windsor also over soft. Azaniya is cross entered at Saint Cloud in France on Sunday.

Sunday

Saint Cloud

R5 Prix Solitude

Azaniya wins if she runs here. She may run at Doncaster in the UK the day before.

R6 Prix Tantieme

Jessica Harrington sends Norwalk Havoc who was an impressive 3 length winner of a listed race at Leopardstown on October 19th. Will take plenty of beating.
