International Racing Tip Sheet

Rosehill, Caulfield - Australia
Newmarket - UK

The Gr1 Dewhurst Stakes for the 2 yrs and the famous Cesarewitch, first ran in 1839, in honour of Tsarevich Alexander, then Crown Prince of Russia, are the big races of the day at Newmarket in the UK. The Dewhurst has a field of 9 strong 2 yr olds or maybe 8 and a rabbit. The Cesarewitch is undersubscribed with only 21 runners going to post. This 2 Mile 2 Furlong race generally goes with close to 40 runners. A quieter weekend in Australia with Gr1 Caulfield Guineas the feature race of the day down there. I do like a few at Rosehill over in Sydney. So we'll start there.

Rosehill

R3 10:45 pm EST Friday

2 (2) God's Window. Maybe more of the expected of this horse when he shipped from the UK from Gosden's barn, but he gets the rise in distance he needs today. I took 7/1 earlier in the week. He is currently 9/2. There may or may not be a bigger race for him later in the Australian Spring. If this is his level (a Benchmark 88) he wins.

R6 00:35 am EST Gr3 Gloaming Stakes

11 (7) Serapo 25/1. Wide open affair. Going with the well drawn, unexposed, impeccably bred by Frankel, Chris Waller trained 3yr old at a price. Currently 25/1. If this is close to 16/1 near post time, then it's worth a punt.

R8 01:50 am EST Gr2 Hill Stakes

Lindermann is in great form and would be a no brainier bet with a low draw, but he is drawn wide in (14), and you are compelled to try and beat him. I like Kovalica also for Waller, but there has already been a hint of money for **10 (8) Kingswood 10/1**, which into 15/2 from 10/1. If the horse drifts back out, maybe ignore it, but right now it's a bet. I took 10/1 earlier today. The formerly Irish trained runner ships up from Melbourne after a sound 2nd in a 15 runner Flemington Handicap. The horse was often a length of two behind some of the O'Brien battalions back in Ireland. This is a Gr2 he can win. Good ground. Good draw. Irish rider Johnny Allen comes up from Melbourne for the ride. Follow the Jockey!

Caulfield

R7 00:50 am EST, Gr1 Toorak Handicap 1 Mile

Advertised as a match race between a picket fence horse Sepals, tipped up on these pages a few months ago and Evaporate. However. I am siding with the New Zealand Oaks winner **9 (10) Leica Lucy 10/1**. Her final closing sectionals were explosive in her first up appearance on Australia. She gets weight from her foes. Her draw suits her come from behind style. She gets one of the world's best riders in Damian Lane and she's 10/1. Follow the Jockey and Fill Your Boots.

R8 01:30 am EST, Gr1 Caulfield Guineas 1 Mile

A stallion making race. I am going back to **2 (10) Wodeton 7/2**, a horse who has let me down on these pages a couple of times. But I feel now is the time to make a statement. The other Waller horse The Autumn Boy may be the better horse, but the 1 post in the mile around Caulfield can be problematic. Wodeton is suited by his wide draw. He gets James McDonald. He may be the Fav, but one with juice in his price. Coolmore would sure like to see this son of the late Wooden Bassett salute here. And Chris Waller is making the trip from Sydney to celebrate with the Magniers.

R10 02:45 am EST, Gr3 Plume Stakes 6F

I am going to take a stab with an Adelaide raider, **5 (6) Prairie Flower 10/1** here. The mare was a closing 4th Gr1 Aussie Star sprinter Asfoora earlier this year. Lachlan Neindorf in town for the ride. Follow the Jockey. 10/1 is a good bet.

Newmarket

R1 08:15 am EST, Gr3 Darley Stakes 9F

4 (5) Damysus 15/8 was entered at Longchamp last Sunday, but was pulled because of the soft going. Gets better ground here. The horse is currently 15/8, which is too short, but the horse should win for Wathnam and Gosden.

R2 08:50 am EST, Gr3 Zetland Stakes 1 Mile 2F

I am aking the other the other Appleby at a price here. I don't like the Buick 1st choice, but **2 (5) Del Maro** with Billy "The Kid" Loughnane booked seems a great Each Way bet at 16/1 in an 8 horse race. Del Maro may still be a maiden after three 1 Mile outings, but he's been super close every time. He's by Camelot out of a German Oaks and will eat up the extra two furlongs. Best value bet of the day.

R3 09:25 am EST, Gr2 Autumn Stake 1 Mile

4 (1) Hankelow 9/4 is well clear of this field on the figs and should prevail for Karl Burke. You'll get a better price because he's not a Godolphin or a Coolmore.

R4 10:00 am EST, Gr1 Dewhurst Stakes 7 Furlongs

This is barn burner of a race. We have Coolmore's Gstaad who was an emphatic Royal Ascot winner. The unbeaten Zavateri who nosed out Gstaad in the Gr1 National Stakes at the Curragh last time is here too. The sneaky good Gosden horse Oxygen with Oisín Murphy up is not without a chance. The other O'Brien horse, Italy is one for whom the penny could drop. But I can get past the Fav **2 (7) Distant Storm 9/4** for Appleby and Buick. Sheikh Mohammed is in Newmarket for the sales. Follow the Owner. This one is special. A rabbit has been booked. Hold on tight!!! 1 (8) Alparsian is currently 18/1 and could be a good place play,

R5 10:40 am EST, Cesarewitch Handicap 2 Miles 2 F

The tipsters in the UK are all going crazy for any Irish horse trained by jumps trainers. I've played that angle many times (and won), but the ground is going to be as fast as there has been in October in Newmarket in many years. This ground may not suit these Irish stayers. I prefer a hold up horse with good to firm form and that would be **2 (4) Divine Comedy 16/1** for Harry Eutace. The mare is returning to form and seems to have been saved for this. I tipped him at Royal Ascot this year when she finished 5th in the Ascot Stakes after a getting blocked down the lane. I like the connections have returned to the young, gifted and black jockey, Kaiya Fraser. The horse did his best running two years ago with Fraser up. The pair have a connection. The race will suit a closer. She carries 15 lbs more than the lightest weighted Irish raider and biggest threat Reverend Hubert 6/1, but you are getting twice the price.
