Race-Day Overview

It is Day 29 of the Saratoga meet and it's another Saratoga Sunday! However, this could potentially be a wet one. Turf races will have ALT picks today, but if any turf race is guaranteed to stay on...it's the featured race, the Grade 3 Mahony Stakes. The Mahony Stakes is highlighted by the ML Favorite "Outfielder"! Let's have a day!

Based on the variable weather patterns in upstate New York, it is imperative that you CHECK FOR SCRATCHES AND CHANGES, because we often send out the SPP's BEFORE scratches are officially posted. So, our final selections might be VERY DIFFERENT if races taken off the turf!! We send out the SPP's early to give you ample amount of time to study and make decisions before the races begin.

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Late P5 Analysis: R6 - 10

This whole card is pretty bland to be honest but that just makes my pick 5 tickets cheaper and more affordable and the ability to maybe press a ticket or two. This late sequence is all centered around the return to Saratoga/United States for top turf horse Outfielder. However, that isn't until leg 4 of the sequence. So, let's start with the first few races of this bunch. Race 6 is a 2yo turf race in which I think you can spread and still not be too confident in who you have. Potential rain in the area as well for these undercard turf races could lead to them being run on dirt. A lot of "what ifs" so if you want to have coverage this is the race to spread. Race 7 is a cheap maiden claiming race and I think it is pretty straightforward. The Chad brown entrant is trying a whole new thing 2nd time out and Chad is pretty good in all of the angles, First time blinkers 22%, the MSW to MCL drop 29%, and the switch from Davis to Prat won't hurt either. Could be a single but the two Linda Rice entrants both can improve enough to win as well. Race 8 is another turf race and if it stays on the turf I think you can get through this race without too much of a spread, but if it comes off the turf, who knows what to think. The Featured race is the Mahony in race 9 and I think that race is Outfielders to lose and should be everyone's single. Finally, you have a mid level claiming race on the dirt and I truly think it is a two horse race between the 3 and 6, both will bring some value on the back end of the sequence and I think that could be a fun way to end it on a cheap ticket.

On the Ledge is the tactical speed of the race. Kendrick Carmouche is in the irons and this is the type of horse Kendrick excels on. The other speed is directly outside this one but is ridden by Katie Davis who isn't nearly as aggressive out the gate as Kendrick. I think the start of this race is where the race will be won today. If Kendrick breaks on top, I don't see many capable closers, however, if he lets Katie duel with him or get a loose lead, his chances may be done. Totally up to Kendrick to take control of this race early and capitalize late when it matters.
