The following are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS. THIS IS A NO-CHALK ZONE....THE WHOLE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION IS TO TIP OUT HORSES THAT ARE UNDER THE RADAR AND COULD PRODUCE VALUE!!

(Reminder, "stars" are rated from 1-5, with 5 being the most confident of plays)

Notes:

Race 5 is where I find my first price/spot play of the day. Fitzpatrick exits a 25k claiming event where he finished behind the two heavy favorites while running for the waiver after a near 10-month layoff. He finds himself getting some slight class relief, down to a 20k claiming tag. Wayne Potts also keeps the waiver on Fitzpatrick, protecting him once again and switching to red-hot jockey Jose Ortiz. Fitzpatrick finds himself second off the bench, in a race loaded with speed, drawn well to the inside. The jockey upgrade to Jose Ortiz is enough for me to give this runner a strong chance of upsetting a field full of inconsistent runners.

RACE 7 IS AN EXCELLENT RACE WHERE DEPICTION IS IN A PERFECT SPOT. DEPICTION COMES IN OFF A RATHER DISSAPOINTING PERFORMANCE IN THE GRADE 3 POKER, BUT FINDS HIMSELF COMING BACK IN A RACE LOADED WITH EARLY PACE. DEPICTION DOESN'T FACE THE LIKES OF BRILLIANT BERTIE OR TOP STAKES HORSES, INSTEAD HE'LL HAVE THE CHANCE TO SHOWCASE THE WICKED TURN OF FOOT HE POSSESES. I BELIEVE YOU WILL GET THE 3-1 ML SEEING AS THE HORSE TO HIS OUTSIDE WILL TAKE A LOT OF PLAY. THIS WILL BE A SINGLE IN MY HORIZONTAL BETS AND I WILL BE SURE TO HAVE A WIN BET ON HIM TOO.

MY **PLAY OF THE DAY** COMES IN THE GRADE 1 SWORD DANCER! FINALLY, WE SEE APPLEBY SEND SOME RUNNERS OUT TO SARATOGA. EL CORDOBES IS A RUNNER WHO HAS FACED SOME TOP QUALITY RUNNERS, ESPECIALLY LAST OUT IN HIS DOMINANT VICTORY IN THE GROUP 2 PRINCE OF WALES STAKES. WITH NATION'S PRIDE ALSO IN THE FIELD, FLAVIEN PRAT WILL TAKE THE MOUNT ON *EL CORDOBES* AS HE WILL LIKELY LAY CLOSE TO THE PACE AND NOT LET ML FAVORITE *FAR BRIDGE* GET TOO FAR AHEAD. *FAR BRIDGE* IS VULNERABLE WHEN HE FACES GOOD EUROPEAN RUNNERS. FLAVIEN PRAT WAS NO STRANGER TO THE WINNER'S CIRCLE IN GRADE 1s LAST YEAR, AND I DON'T BELIEVE TODAY WILL BE ANY DIFFERENT!

My final price/spot play of the day comes in the nightcap, where leading rider Irad Ortiz is listed at 5-1 ML on the best closer in a race with FOUR horses who need the lead, and a couple others that do their best running forward. The outside post is not a concern, with all the speed, I expect Irad to guide Charles J over to the rail and save ground as the pace materializes up front. Blinkers go on to add some focus to this runner as he unleashes his turn of foot as others get leg weary.
