Today's Pick 5 Analysis

We close out the week with a fun pick 5 sequence that I thought was very difficult to narrow down. Starting off is an impossible turf sprint where I'm hoping the favorite is vulnerable as she's drawn inside of her main pace rival who is arguably quicker. In the next leg, I suppose Margarita's Girl will be the biggest key to the sequence as she's likely to be the shortest price and singled on many tickets, but I didn't think she was a lock by any means. Things do not get any easier in a wide open edition of the Eddie Read and then we finish up with two more wide open races in the late double. Terrific sequence that should pay well so get involved horizontally and vertically!

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses we like that will provide some value (typically 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT DEL MAR!!! I've been waiting for **#4 Won For Lou** to run back ever since his debut at Santa Anita. That race was a total prep and I actually thought he ran pretty well. He was quick enough to establish position from the rail going five furlongs and just chased the top two around the track to finish third. The top two finishers are both well regarded prospects so no shame in finishing third, and I love that he galloped out strongly. Now he stretches out to two turns, picks up the best turf jockey in the colony, and has the experience/stamina edge over the majority of his rivals. All systems go.

Notes:

This maiden race feels like it's begging to fall apart late. Baffert has two very speedy fillies that are suspect in the lane and the same could be said for Margarita Girl, the morning line favorite who has one way to go and finds herself sandwiched between the two Baffert's. Throw in the Mandella filly who reportedly has plenty of speed, and note the 6.5 furlong distance of this sprint. I like a **#3 A Friend of Mine** from off the pace. I know this is a step up in class, but I'm not sure if this field is really that much tougher than what she's been facing (outside of the favorite) and she's supposed to get a great set-up. Her one sprint came in her debut and she ran well from off the pace to finish second by a nose to a next out winner and I thought her second start was respectable too. Now she's paired up Beyer-tops, she's working very well in the mornings, and she cuts back to a distance that could hit her right between the eyes. Lots to like.

The favorites in the nightcap can absolutely win but I find them uninspiring. **#4 Goatski** could be a heavy favorite in here, but she got a big pace set-up that day, that turf Beyer has not held up, and she lacks any early speed. **#5 Hello Kid O Kid O** is the other logical but she's had plenty of chances at this point and often finds trouble. Give me the upside of **#9 Royal Dusty** at a MASSIVE price. I thought she ran better than looked in both starts. The debut seemed like a prep when they placed her behind horses and she passed a few to just finish evenly in a sprint. Then she stretched out on the grass and was a step slow and lost valuable position early. She was rank the entire race and looking to do more, but just never found clear sailing at any point. I actually like this outside post for her because it gives her a better chance to recover and get forward if she breaks slow again. And I do hope Kimura puts her into the race since there's very little speed. Note the recent step up in the mornings for a trainer that typically races his horses into shape.
