Howard's Late Pick 5 Analysis - Races 6 - 10

The last Pick 5 of the 2025 Fall Meet is VERY difficult, so if you're playing, make sure you have some money in your pocket to bet...or play thin and hope you're 'capping is amazing. Races 8 and 9 are skullbusters, and R7 and R10 are not easy either. I'd probably single in the opening leg, R6, with the #6 and cross my fingers. I do like a price in the G3 Fayette in #5 Moonlight....I think the favorites are vulnerable, especially in that race.

We'll start with a firster that has looked VERY good in the morning. And, if you were a fan Kobe Bryant, be ready to cheer on **#3 Remember Mamba**. This field does not impress me, and Remember Mamba works in the a.m. are solid. He's by Kitten's Joy, so that should help him appreciate the grass, because



the dam side is nothing special. Trainer DeVaux can pop with a firster once in a while, and she reaches out to Jose Ortiz. Let the board be your guide, but if he's less than his ML at post time, look out! Hope he slam dunks this field.

VERY tough race....Ward has two in the race, one speed, and one who I think can rate a bit if necessary. On paper, there's PLENTY of early gas, and #12 Muffin Music is a big filly that will 1) appreciate being outside of the speed, and 2) takes the blinks off and will hopefully settle a little better early. The works are very good lately, and I'm hoping the horse takes to the dirt like she does in the a.m.

The Bowman Mill S. is fascinating. #3 Outfielder is going to the Breeders' Cup and will scratch. That leaves a field of 5, and literally no one is capable of closing from off the pace. That leads to what I think is the best OUTSIDE speed, and that's **#6 Gallivant**, who is still a maiden. But he faced a VERY good field first out and hung around late with an 89 Beyer. If you're to believe that, he's the horse to beat and class of the field, yet he's 7-2 ML. I don't know if he can rate a bit if necessary, but drawing outside the speed gives him options. He's bred VERY well and Machado rides again...I like, probably at 5-2-ish.

A solid rendition of the Fayette S....**#5 Moonlight** won for me last time, and I truly believe he can show himself well in this tougher spot today...maybe more underneath, but can win too. Trainer Chris Block is a veteran trainer, and an excellent one. The horse is coming into his own, and there's plenty of early speed to set up his close...he'll be further back than last time. He had to wait last time in behind horses, and closed really well. He might have to go wide today, but look for him late to pick up major pieces. For our ROI, we'll go \$1 to win and \$3 to place.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT KEENELAND! And, it's the last race of the meet, so let's go out with a bang! It would help if the #1 scratches, because he's a major threat and cross-entered in NY today. Even if he's in, I like #3 Practical Joker (10-1). He's broken slow from the gate in his first two starts, but puts blinkers on, so I hope that helps. Last time, he was in a bit tight in the stretch that didn't help. He's no



superstar, but this field looks weak to me on paper, and he's as fast as anyone in here so far. Inside post and underrated trainer in Stidham gives me even more confidence. Trainer is 5-for-10 with blinks added going long with maidens since 2024!! I think we're looking at somewhere around 6-1, but I'd take that. Good luck!

Key Horse of the Sequence: Let's go to R8, a \$6,250 claimer with a big field. There's a lot of "meh" in this race, with many not getting me excited to bet them. So I'll go with a



fresh face that has early speed, the #2 A Rousing Babe (4-1). She has plenty of back-class from Emerald Downs near Seattle, and a very good trainer/jockey for the level to boot. If she breaks well and establishes and early lead like she should, I believe she'll be tough to run down in the lane. There aren't many gals in this race that like to pass others. Wire-to-wire job at 3-1? I hope so!
