### P5 Analysis

Friday's late sequence seems like more of a "spread early, skinny late" type of philosophy. Like I did last Friday, I'm going with a pick 4 for the caveman bet. Race 4 is a wide open maiden event where nobody seems to want to win and Race 6 is the Real Good Deal stakes for some very mediocre 3-year-old boys. I would advise to spread as much as possible in both of those legs. In my opinion, there's only a few horses that can win the last race, so I'm gonna try and get alive to the #11 Moonlight Tryst.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1-5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

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A first time starter going 5 furlongs on the turf? Is Noah nuts? It's very possible. Richard Baltas sends out the #6 Scipio for his debut in Race 3. In a field full of first time starters, Scipio seems to have the best turf breeding of the bunch. Baltas has done what Doug O'neil and some other San Luis Rey trainers do: ship them over to Del Mar to get a work or two on the track before debuting. It's a minor detail in the grand scheme of things, but I've seen it work on a number of occasions. If his works are any indication of his talent, look out. Important to note that Richard Baltas is 4/14 when he debuts in a turf sprint at Del Mar over the last 5 years.

Race 7 is just another one of those maiden turf routes where some weird things can happen, and this time I think the #3 Hannah Buckle could be a part of it. This is a filly for Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners who ran twice in Ireland and then made her stateside debut in April, and that stateside debut was nothing more than a prep. She didn't have all that much speed out of the gate and kinda lagged behind on the inside, but she was never at all really asked to give her best, and still actually made up some ground on the field. She gets more ground today, and her pedigree points COMPLETELY towards going long on the turf. The rails are out quite a bit today, which in theory doesn't really help closers, but I can only hope that bullet work of 3f in 36 flat means she'll be closer than last time.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT DEL MAR!!! Like I mentioned earlier, I'm going to try to end my day with the #11 Moonlight Tryst. To be quite honest, this is a really bad field, and I feel like there's really only a handful that can win. He was 2-1 on debut and just lost by a nose, then he was 5/2 in a turf race where Hofmans added the blinkers and they tried to get to the front end. First time in the new



barn, first time in for a tag, blinkers come back off, gets back to the preferred surface, you name it. I see the 1 and the 12 battling for the lead and him sitting a perfect trip right in behind. Important to note that Dean Pederson is 22% MSW to MCL and he's 32% turf to dirt over the last 5 years.
