P5 Analysis

Today's sequence is not at all one to take lightly. No stakes during this part of the day, but some very good betting races on the card. Horizontal bettors might try and put their trust in Baffert by singling Gaming in Race 7, but that seems to be a pretty good bunch of 2yo's he's



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gotta take down. For me, it's all about getting alive to the last race, where I have a strong opinion in the #4 Dealers Special.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

Of the main contenders, the #4 Yerwanthere is the one I want going this distance of 1 mile 1/16. She had been facing some of the better female turf routers on the West Coast, and once she thought she got some class relief, she finished 2nd behind Lunar Impact and Hang the Moon, who ran 2nd and 5th in the Osunitas earlier on in the meet. She's got a really nice late kick and always comes with a run, and I think that late burst helps her get that extra ground that others might not want.

Let's not sugarcoat it: the #7 In Suspense ran absolutely awful last time. Even though he did, he was working extremely well going into that race, and the connections have decided to wheel him back in a timely manner and into a spot that is much more doable. He was a head off of the 7-5 here two starts back, so there is no doubt he can run with these at his best, but the question may be if he's capable of wiring the field on this turf course.

Since being transferred to the Baltas barn, he's been slightly disappointing, losing as 5-2 and 7-5 favorites. But since that last effort, he's been gelded, and judging by his works, have made all the difference. Those works have been so promising that Richard Baltas decides to move up in class and protect him. His numbers before the equipment change are right with the main contenders here, and he seems to be getting better with every start. There's every reason in the



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world to believe there's going to be another step forward, and Rispoli should have him very well situated, presumably midpack.
