Friday's Late Pick 5 could be pretty chalky...until you get to the last race. It is a wide open \$16k claimer where just about anyone could win. In the feature, I don't think Linda's Gift has to win, but if she does lose, I have a feeling it'll be by someone she hasn't faced before, so I threw in the 1 and 5 incase of such an occasion.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1-5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

The #1 Apple Valley Girl is typically the type of horse I'm against. A huge price on debut, now a much shorter price 2nd time, and for a very small barn. But the way she ran on debut has me intrigued. She showed some natural speed, she had a slight bobble around the turn, and still was actually coming with a little run in the lane and galloped out really nicely. Apple Valley Girl is a full sister to a horse named Clubhouse Bride, who was very successful early on in her career, and this field is not great, so it won't take huge improvement to better this field.

Steve Knapp has gotten him some rest, he's working well, and it's hard for me to imagine him not sitting a really good trip in behind the speed.
