Today's Analysis

Saturday's Late Pick 5 is highlighted by the Grade 1 Del Mar Oaks, which contains some shippers and some that have already run once at Del Mar. The two main contenders are the #1 Iscreamuscream and the #3 Whiskey Decision, and I really think it's between one of those two. I'm going to try to get things kicked off with the #1 Fleet Feet in Race 6, and if he doesn't win, I'll come back and play the ole pick 4.



Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 - 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

The #9 Thought Process ran fine on debut, but I have much reason to believe he'll be a winner 2nd time out. His debut was going 5.5F on first, and like I said, was a respectable effort for a first time starter. His breeding completely points toward going long on the turf, and D'amato is definitely the guy you want when trying to perform in that scenario. I believe D'amato used that debut to get him ready for this race, as he's been stationed down at Del Mar and working very solid here. I'll be trying to get him in the exacta with one of the McCarthy first time starters.

Boy am I a sucker for claim backs, and we've got one here with the #7 Departure. He's re-entering Steve Knapp's barn, I like that he's dropped in down because 1) a class relief is always beneficial and 2) he's most likely to lose him again anyways, so might as well run in a reasonable spot to rack up purse money on top of the \$12.5k. He's not going to get nearly as much pace pressure as he has in his last two starts, so as long as he breaks well, he could go wire to wire.
