P5 Analysis

The way you play your Late Pick 5 on Friday all depends on whether you think Seismic Beauty can lose in R6. I am always handicapping with the motive of beating favorites, so I would lean toward trying to beat her, but she just got beat by a really nice filly in One Magic Philly last time, so I would not discredit you at all for going the single route. If you do single her, the place for a bit of a price would most likely be Race 9. Otherwise the sequence has the potential to be a bit chalky.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

Race 3 could very well be won by one of the logicals (#1, #2, or #9), but I think the #3 Renatus is primed for a big improvement in her second start. She debuted going 5.5F on the dirt, and not only did she break slow and get shuffled back to last, but she debuted during a time of the meet where the main track was EXTREMELY speed favoring. She was wide on the far turn and actually made up some ground, and showed some ability that could be further aided by a stretch out in distance. The turf may be a bit of a question mark, but she's a full sister to Curlin's Kaos, who has won twice on the grass and actually won the Real Good Deal at the beginning of the month. She also attracts Hector Berrios, who is riding exceptionally well, especially on turf.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT DEL MAR!!! If Seismic Beauty were to lose, I think the #2 Dashingly is a very intriguing alternative. Shirreffs started her on the grass where she showed speed against some pretty decent groups of maidens. In that race on August 3rd, she got the lead once again, but she broke from the rail and had to work hard to get, and they went 44 % for the half mile. That was off a bit of a layoff, so she could have needed that race. She got a bullet work on August 21st, and Shirreffs doesn't work like that very often, so I'm hoping her performance in the morning is indicative of her fitness. I'll be playing a heavy 6/2 exacta, and I'll play it the other way lightly just in case she does strike the upset.

We've kinda seen what these California-based horses can do, so I'm going with a fresh face in the #6 Dr. Ray D. This is a ship in win entrant for Bob Hess, who really has a niche for these low level claimers, and if you remember, was the trainer of Cajun Brother, who was tipped out by yours truly earlier in the meet. She's never been on the dirt before, but I don't really see a reason why she won't

like it. She's also one of the only runners that looks like they want to pass horses. The 5.5F should be perfect for her, it's just a matter of if that pace is on early and Cedillo works out a nice trip.
