P5 Analysis

Boy did I have a hard time narrowing down my Late Pick 5 ticket to \$120. There are several difficult races ranging anywhere from 8k claimers in the first leg to an extremely talented



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field of 3-year-olds in R10. Maybe the single would be Smokem if U Gottem in R9, but he's already had 3 chances to break the maiden and really had no excuse last time. Other than that, I can't even sniff another potential single in this sequence. This sequence is definitely worth the investment, and one I could see paying very well.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

The #6 Rizzleberry Rose is definitely one of those who falls under the category of "trying to close on a speed favoring main track". She didn't break great in the debut, was climbing down the backside, and then once she really started running, the bias limited her to only doing so much running. Now she's 2nd time out for Knapp and Tiago Pereira, who tends to ride a lot of these state-bred maidens for Knapp and owner Terry Lovingier. Now she has blinkers on and that experience under her belt, so I expect bigger and better things second time out.

He was bet down to 7/2 from a 6-1 morning line, so the general public had the same idea. But now he switches to Hess, who if I haven't said it enough, excels at these low level claimers. You know Maldonado is going to have him close to the pace, and I expect an effort similar to what he's shown in the past, besides that last one obviously

That was his first race off of a bit of a lay off, so I expect him to be plenty fit this afternoon. He should be in a great place to get the job down. Keep in mind, Tim Yakteen won a maiden race yesterday and is very good a getting his horses to break their maiden at Del Mar.
