We send out the SPP's early to give you ample amount of time to study and make decisions before the races begin. P5 Analysis

The Late Pick5 on Saratoga Sunday is a really interesting sequence highlighted by the 2-YO Grade 3 Adirondack stakes sprinting on the dirt. With the top race featuring 2YO, the sequence inherently becomes more interesting and tougher, especially since there are no standouts in this race. Not to mention that the races built around are dificult also, so we are in for a good puzzle today. However, there are a couple pace scenarios that might help us narrow down some of the races as we try to build the bankroll for the rest of the Saratoga season.





Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

I will admit, the turf sprint is usually a race I stay away from due to all of the different variables that can go wrong in such short races that immediately take you out of winning contention. However, every now and again a spot pops up that looks too good, and that is the #9 Tiffany Gold. For once it seems like there isn't a whole lot of pace signed on for a turf sprint, and Tiffany Gold should get a perfect pressing trip just off the leader. Luis Saez has the mount of this lightly raced filly, which leaves no doubt in my mind that with a good aggressive ride, she should be in the mix come the wire.

Another race where I am taking a shot with a horse I don't normally play, but this is the type of card for that as it is putting me a little outside my comfort zone. #8 Chattalot is a horse who has not won in a long time, dating back to 2022, however, this is a race that sets up perfectly for him as there looks to be little to no early resistance that is nearly as fast as he is out of the gate. With the way the Churchill Downs form has held up at Saratoga this year coupled with the very strong pace advantage on paper, Chattalot looks to be in a prime position to get back to the winners circle.

As contrarian as can be to the previous race, on paper the Adirondack Stakes looks like nearly everyone wants the lead in a two-year-old stake where there are many question marks about horses wanting to rate. That leads me to look for horses who have passed in previous races and done it professionally, which helps the one I landed on, ridden by Prat. #2 Italian Soiree debuted at Aqueduct on July 4th and sat behind the leaders, moved past on the far turn and finished with a strong kick over a 3/5 well-meant Repole runner. There are many question marks with these two-year-olds as usual.





But what Italian Soiree showed on debut, plus so much speed in the race on paper, "Italian" should sit a perfect trip under the hottest jockey in the colony at the moment.
