Picks Tip Sheet

I'm going to take some stabs on today's Price Plays/Spot Plays with some first-time starters. Good Lord Lorrie (GLL) is an interesting firster for red-hot George Weaver, who's hitting at $30 \%$ for the meet. I'll be using this one PURELY AS AN UNDERNEATH HORSE FOR THE ROI, \$1 Ex. 7-4 and \$1 Place \#4. He received a B+ workout last time (albeit on dirt) and this son of Hard Spun is out a damn named Spinning Wheel who won almost $\$ 100 \mathrm{k}$ and was FAST early. Weaver is $40 \%$ in the money with babies going first out sprinting on the turf. Check the board before the race, but have a feeling this one can run....and the \#7, while a likely winner, will be WAY overbet.

Race 5 is ABSOLUTELY LOADED with talented firsters, and it's the first 2yo dirt race scheduled for 6 f . Clement has a firster here, the \#5 Deterministic, that has a bunch of things going for him. First, he's well-bred and cost $\$ 625$. Second, he's been working lights with B and B+ works, and I love that he's been working in behind horses taking dirt, then learning how to finish. There are a bunch of good ones in the family, some with turf success, so the fact that the Clement's are running this one on dirt is a good sign to me. The rail horse might be a handful, but the hunch here is that Deterministic will be flying late and has a serious future. If not today on the win end, down the road for sure.

Maybe the outside horse is the goods, but I want to see it again, and I trust Todd and Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners as ownership on the \#4 more than the \#6's connections. We'll see.
