Late P5 Analysis

This late Pick5 is very challenging as it has three very interesting opening races in two Maiden Special Weights, one for 2YO and the other for 3YO and up, and it also includes a really nice N1X allowance race. Then this sequence ends with two challenging claiming races, which then presents a tough sequence with many different avenues to go down. As shown above, I actually decided to single in the first, spread in the next two, then go skinny in the claiming races. Although they are generally tougher, I believe there are a few horses among the rest which stand out to me, which leads me to take my stands later rather than early, besides the single of course.

** THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT SARATOGA ** The #4 Gram in the Bolton Landing strikes me as a horse who comes into a stakes race fresh and coming off of two really good races from her even though she had a lot of trouble speaks volumes to me of how strong and courageous this filly really is. The numbers may be slow, but she looks to get a better trip in a spot like this from the four hole in a race with a LOT of speed. I don't normally like to have closers in a short turf sprint like the Bolton Landing, but I think #4 GRAM will trip out behind the speed on paper and swing out at the ¼ pole underneath Joel, who is coming off a big win in the Alabama with Randomized. We will also be pairing #4 Gram in a double with my top two picks in the next to hopefully create a little more value with her.

Race 5 brings a lot of talented fillies, most of whom have not hit the track but have a lot of aspirations to go on to do big things. I think one of the top choices in that regard is the 1 MILLION dollar OBS 2023 2YO purchase, the #6 Munny Rockette for Bill Mott, Junior Alvarado and Frank Fletcher. This 2YO daughter of Munnings is a half to two winners, one on turf for Chad and the other for Austin Gustafson down at Lone Star by 6 ¼ and 9 ½ lengths in her last two. This filly has also been working lights out on the Oklahoma Training Track recording 2 "B" level workouts and one "B+" on the clocker reports, which is the highest level usually given to these 2YO's. I like the post that she draws as it should keep this baby outside of other horses so hopefully Junior can give #6 Munny Rockette a clean trip and have enough late like the works suggest.

The 6th race is another 2YO Maiden Special for fillies, but they will be going a mile and a sixteenth on the inner turf course, and there are many different contenders in this competitive field. I think one of them stands out from the rest and that is the #8 Lamorna for Bill Mott and Luis Saez. Even though this filly showcased no speed in her last start, she was squeezed at the start which caused her to be pushed back to last very early on in the race. I think this Munnings filly will appreciate a little bit more ground as Mott stretches her out from 5 ½ furlongs last time and she is a full sister to Eddie the Great, who has run well at a mile/mile and a sixteenth on the dirt and turf as well as having the pedigree to go long as well. Be on the lookout for Lamorna to be mid-pack early and to be flying late with the strong Luis Saez piloting her.

To close out the Power Picks, Race 8 is a very nice Maiden Special going 7 Furlongs on the dirt out of the backstretch chute, and there is one horse I am very interested in. The #9 Black Rain for Pletcher, Irad and A1A Racing looks to be very live on the workout tab, running back to back "B" level workouts in company with very strong gallop-outs according to the clocker report, which suggests this filly is geared up for this longer sprint first time out. The other very strong angle I have is #9 Black Rain is also a half to Ethereal Road, who is a horse a lot of people recognize from the D Wayne Lukas barn for coming second in The Rebel Stakes in 2022 to Un Ojo, amd winning the Sir Barton stakes at Pimlico on Preakness Day that same year. He is also a half to turf graded stakes winning Turned Aside from the Linda Rice and Mark Casse barns. With the siblings the dam has produced and this horse showing up strong on the work tab, #9 Black Rain could be out to make a major impression and I love that he draws the outside post in a field of 9 out of the chute. I have complete faith that Irad can find a great trip for him clear of horses to make a good run down the stretch.
