Based on the variable weather patterns in upstate New York<u>, it is imperative that you</u> <u>CHECK FOR SCRATCHES AND CHANGES</u>, because we often send out the SPP's BEFORE scratches are officially posted. So, our final selections might be VERY DIFFERENT if races taken off the turf!! If that's the case and Spot/Price Plays involve surface changes, those picks will NOT count towards the ROI Stats! We send out the SPP's early to give you ample amount of time to study and make decisions before the races begin. Late P5 Analysis

The Late Pick5 on Saratoga Friday is not easy, as there are three maiden races that highlight this ending sequence along with the feature turf sprint. These baby races look very good, however it makes the sequence very tough when looking at it from a horizontal standpoint. However, there are a couple pace scenarios in the non-maidens that might help us narrow down as we try to build the bankroll one last time before the end of the season.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses I like that will provide some value (hopefully 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 - 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

Coming out of the Wilson Chute at Saratoga this year hasn't been too kind to both horses drawn outside, and horses closing from the back this meet, which could leave the favorites here in a vulnerable position. **#5 Pam Pam (4-1)** should sit just off in second flight with Irad aboard and should get a good jump on horses like **#1** Backstretch Rose as they reach the top of the stretch. There is pace in front of her as well with the **#2**, **#3** and **#4** all wanting a piece of the lead, so that doesn't concern me either.

The highlight of the card is the G3 Saranac, and I think there could be a pretty decent upset here. I loved the #1 West Hollywood last time, but this is a much different scenario than last time and at a low price my eyes looked elsewhere. **#6 The Process (9-2)** ran at Colonial Downs last time against arguably easier competition than others in here, however he blew the doors off that field winning by 4 and achieving a beyer which puts him well into contention. This will be a test for sure for him, however he's done everything right so far to warrant a chance and the value is correct to take a shot.

For those that have been following the show, they know that this race is not something I would normally choose for my best bet of the day. However, it isn't every day that you find a turf sprint at Saratoga with not a lot of speed up front and many of the favorites wanting to close from far out of it. This leaves my top pick **#5 Candi Girl (9-2)** looking like she might have an advantage in this race, sitting just off the #3 and going by, getting the jump on a lot of the horses who will be low prices. A formallystaked horse at Presque Isle looks to get a little class relief here to hopefully get her confidence up for bigger things ahead.
