Today's Pick 5 Analysis

I think both Pick 5's on this Friday card could be very rewarding if you're able to string five winners together. In terms of the Late Pick 5, the shortest priced favorite is Om N Joy in the Fleet Treat at 5-2, and that is a salty bunch of 3yo fillies. It's a good variety of both sprints and routes on both dirt and turf, and a mixture of good quality fields and not-so-good quality to really challenge the handicapper and their ability to hone in on opinions.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses we like that will provide some value (typically 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT DEL MAR!!! There is an abundance of speed in this \$16k claimer, and I'm hoping it sets up for the **#7 Gypsy Tears**. His two dirt sprints this year completely fit with this group. He ran into Lonesome Stew in his comeback race, who's won 4 of his last 5 including a stake, and was third behind Jerry's Spirit two starts back, who was in the middle of a 4-race win streak of his own. Yes, he has yet to hit the board in four starts at Del Mar, but two of those were 4th's last summer against much tougher and in races that were won by horses on or near the lead. Everybody go so he can clean up.

Tactical speed from an inside post is always a huge advantage in these turf routes at Del Mar, especially when the rails are out. **#2 Lavender Love** showed some speed in her debut but was up on heels early and got shuffled back. She tried to make another run, but got steadied down on the inside, and galloped out like there was more there. The bottom side of her pedigree is a bit sprinty, but Grazen's can pretty much do it all. Hoping she sits the pocket in behind the three speedy outside rivals. Had a really nice work last time here at Del Mar in company with older Sweet Gal of Mine.

This speed-filled card continues with the featured Fleet Treat, and **#7 Lady Mendelssohn** could get the right trip in here. She was down on the inside in her first dirt try in the Melair, which isn't the most ideal trip considering she'd only been on turf and had never experienced kickback. Carla Gaines could've gone right back to the turf with her, but throws her back in a wide open dirt sprint, which should be to her benefit with the cutback in distance. Both Antonio Garcia runners are very fast, and the Delaware invader should have some speed as well. Maybe Umberto can get the jump on the favorite #3 **Om N Joy**.
