If that's the case and Spot/Price Plays involve surface changes, those picks will NOT count towards the ROI Stats! We send out the DMPP's early to give you ample time to study and make decisions before the races begin. Today's Pick 5 Analysis

Adding even more excitement to Friday's program is a double carryover in the Pick 6, creating an enticing wagering opportunity for horseplayers looking to chase a potentially lucrative payout. With added money already in the pool and a challenging card on tap, Friday shapes up as one of the most attractive betting days of the Del Mar meet. A race like the Fleet Treat, with two choices that will dominate the wagering, is an essential race when constructing these horizontal tickets. I'm more inclined to take a shot with She's No Quant rather than Mohaven, who might have a bit more upside than the ML favorite. If you want to throw in a price or two, I would suggest both the 5 and 10, but I would highly advise against doubling the ticket using two short priced horses. The nice thing about today's card, and many cards this summer at Del Mar, is there are ample opportunities to find value within the sequence. I've got a couple late prices that could bump up the payout. Maybe even a triple carryover into Saturday?

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses we like that will provide some value (typically 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

According to timeform, Allihies' winter form puts her squarely in the mix, but when you really go through it, it seems like you can make excuses for a majority of her recent races. She was thrown to the wolves in two consecutive tries following a maiden claiming score, managed to find trouble in a five horse field here at Del Mar in November, and was caught way wide in her first try at Oaklawn. Clearly something happened last time, but she took legit money in there, Kitchingman has had her training for quite some time now, and they bother to bring her back protected. That's enough for me to find out if she's ready to roll against this group.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT DEL MAR!!! I love betting back horses that incur wide and uncovered trips on this Del Mar turf course, even if you have to go all the way back to November 28th to find it. Not only was Arrakis wide and uncovered, the race itself was heavily dominated by horses with speed and inside trips, and it's pretty evident Arrakis was neither of those. His race here on September 7th of last year puts him squarely in the mix, and if he didn't have to duck to the inside midstretch, he might've gotten there in time. He comes in here off a pretty lengthy layoff, but you rarely worry about these types of layoffs with Phil D'amato, not to mention he stepped up big when spending over 8 months on the bench before his 3yo debut. Who's to say there isn't still some upside with this 4yo gelding?

I realize that there needs to be a defection for Monsieur Big to get into the field, but the 1 is cross-entered into a small field on Sunday, and it's also possible somebody else could scratch, so there's a strong likelihood of him drawing in. He's always been a horse that's been on my radar, simply because you don't ever see hall-of-fame rider Johnny V take a mount on a 2yo for Tim Yakteen, so immediately there was some intrigue. Outside of a strong gallop out, he didn't do all that much running first time out, but I thought his turf try looked better visually than it did on paper. He didn't break all that well (again), had to wait a good bit for some clear running room, then closed just fine into a pace that completely held together. Yes he's been off for some time, and yes he draws the far outside, but he's been working tremendously in the morning, and those doubts will certainly be baked into the price.
