Race-Day Overview

Another Sunday with beautiful weather forecasted. Saratoga had significant rain yesterday, as the later races were taken off the turf. Although I believe races will stay on the turf today with beautiful weather, I will be including off turf picks for the whole card (picks will be highlighted in red). Outside of that small potential hiccup, this card is tough! I think you can make some really decent coin today and it is all centered around the featured race today...The Quick Call in race 9!

Based on the variable weather patterns in upstate New York, it is imperative that you CHECK FOR SCRATCHES AND CHANGES, because we often send out the SPP's BEFORE scratches are officially posted. So, our final selections might be VERY DIFFERENT if races taken off the turf!! We send out the SPP's early to give you ample amount of time to study and make decisions before the races begin.

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Late P5 Analysis: R6 - 10

This sequence is TOUGH...Everything circles around the speed fest in the Quick Call. I think this sequence is tougher than the last time I did this sheet on opening weekend. It starts with a full field of 2yos sprinting on the dirt. I like the #6 Braums Run a good bit in that field but with it being 2yos, single at your own peril. Then we get into the first of 3 turf races. A smaller field in this 7th race but a competitive one nonetheless. I think it goes through three horses, #5 Snipsnippitysnip, #7 Vronti, and #8 Sol D'oro. The 8th race is the last dirt race of the sequence and this is a 2 horse race in my opinion. Will it be #3 Envision a Kentucky shipper 2nd off the layoff for the red hot Will Walden and jockey Irad Ortiz Jr, or will it be the horse directly outside of him in the #4 Iron Dome the 9/5 ML Favorite shipping in for Asmussen. The next leg is the featured race of the day...The Quick Call Stakes. Holy hell, this is a tough bunch of fast sprinters on the turf. I ultimately landed on 3 horses who I think can be tough in this spot, however, I think #3 Throckmorton is the best value throughout the whole card and will be a spot play I will be basing my day around. Finally, the sequence ends on a very boring 2 turn claiming race for N2L horses. I think you can go multiple ways to end the ticket but I think the #5 Artistic Success and #8 Doppio Espresso are the two you need.

Mr R T is the speed here to me. It has been 10 career races and this one has yet to find the winner's circle. However, this one has been knocking on the door for quite some time. Prat stays with this one and this one has all the early speed in the world to make some noise in a very bland bunch of maidens. Add blinkers which this horse hasn't seen since his first 3 career races, all resulting in bad efforts. Now he is in a part of his career that I think the blinkers will actually help. Good value as well.

This is my play of the day! Killa Sally is one of two McPeck horses he is shipping in from Kentucky. This one though, I think is the speed here out of those two McPeck horses. I think this one is going to be able to sit just off the speed line up outside of her and should be able to trip out under the best jockey in the world right now, Jose Ortiz. The flat mile is also what I think this one wants. Also, add in the bullet work over the Saratoga main track 9 days ago and this one seems to be in the perfect spot.

Braums Run tried turf first time out and ran a respectable race but it is clear that he prefers dirt. Golden Pal has been a good sire for 2yos on both surfaces and the dam has a small group of offspring but the best runners have been in dirt sprints. These connections also wouldn't hesitate to keep this one of turf if they thought the ability was better on that surface than dirt. I think the switch to dirt in only his 2nd career start and to run this one at Saratoga...proves to me that this one should improve on the dirt and in a field of question marks, I think this one should have the upper hand when it matters most.

This could have been my best bet of the day but this field is just too tough to single. I think this one is going to be really tough in this spot however. Throckmorton is one of the only horses in this field that can rate his natural speed back and make a run at the hot pace. Luis Saez is in the irons and we all know what Saez is capable of in these spots. This one has the ability to run on dirt as well in case the rain Saturday is so severe, that this somehow is switched to dirt. This is the best value on the day and a horse that I think should be on everyone's tickets and will be pressed on all of mine.
