Late P5 Strategy/Analysis (R6 - 10)

The late Pick 5 to close out the Keeneland meet is an opportunity to get a little skinny with some strong opinions coupled with a heavy favorite. Early on, there are a couple races that even though I have decent opinions, would be hard to single. This is evident with the second leg (Race 7) which is a 2YO maiden race with some standouts, but picking one would be so tough. The #7 is half to Life Is Good and Most Wanted, both graded stake winners, but the #1 is half to Botanical and Dive Bomber, so good pedigree there as well. I have singled the most likely winner on the day in my opinion in Race 9, even though he is off of a 7-month layoff. If he runs back to his races last year, he will be very tough in a spot with a favorable pace scenario. I will say though, if the 13 gets in Race 10, he is a must use in this sequence.

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\$3 Turf P3 Strategy/Analysis - R5, R8, and R10

The Turf Pick3 is always worth a look and with my best play of the day included in the middle leg, it allows the opportunity to spread a little in the other legs, including the addition of some prices. The #12 Partir (12-1) is a first time shipper from overseas for Riley Mott and Johnny V, and her timeform ratings at 3 can put her right in the mix, especially with this being her first start at 4. The last race is an interesting mix for the last race of the meet, a lot of horses are right there with each other. But if the 13 gets in, he is an absolute must use to close out this sequence.

In a race where no one really stands out, I like #7 Eternal Silence for Clement. I liked her last time and was a Spot Play on these tip sheets. She got an incredibly weird ride / trip at a big number and stuck around late. I expect her to show speed here, and I find it fascinating that the connections decide to stretch her out to the marathon distance...maybe that was the long-term plan all along? With the presence of the #2 and #3, I think we'll get that 4-1. Rosario, the barn's "go-to" guy, stays on, hmmm...

Notes:

#1 **Deep Satin** has been a horse who has shown strong talent ever since she debuted at Keeneland last year, only losing by a length to future G3 winner Waves of Mischief. Cherie Devaux has had a tough spring meet after lighting up the tote board in the fall at almost 30% on the win end, but she hasn't been far off this as she has had multiple running late and just missing. #1 Deep Satin looks poised to take advantage of a favorable pace scenario in front of her for the first race of her four-year-old campaign.

Notes:

In a complete 180 from the race previous, Race 6 looks to be completely devoid of front-end speed, which looks to set up my pick, #1 **Tiarella**, to have the lead all by herself second off the layoff. Trainer Horacio De Paz wins at a 16% clip second off a layoff of this length bringing a \$1.96 ROI to boot, so he is no stranger to having live runners under these types of circumstances. Unfortunately for our price, Irad hops aboard but that should favor this horse well to get the correct trip coming off the performance of her life.

Even though she hasn't won a race since coming over to the states, #2 **Immensity** for Bill Mott has run super well against multiple graded stake winners including Beach Bomb, Be Your Best and La Mehana, all of which would be a super low price in this spot. Prat has been exceptional all meet, but also in these long distance turf races, just winning one on Thursday sitting right where this horse should be in theory. She should be raring to go second off the layoff for Bill Mott who does extremely well in these types of situations to kick the connection's 2025 into gear.

The last race of the 2025 Keeneland spring meet is shaping up to be a fantastic betting race, and would be very fitting if Brendan Walsh won the last to cap off an absolutely tremendous meet for him with the #11 **Sumood**. This colt is owned by famed owners Shadwell Stable and looks poised to improve off a very impressive debut only losing by a neck to Dairago who



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got the jump on him that day. Sumood is by Kitten's Joy and out of an Irish bred mare who won the Breeders Cup Filly and Mare Turf in 2007, and even though her progeny haven't been quite up to her caliber yet, the long turf pedigree is there. With Jose Ortiz vying for the spring jockey title, this would be a perfect way to cap off his meet on the late running Samood.
