Today's Pick 5 Analysis

Friday's Late Pick 5 at Del Mar looks like a challenging sequence that should offer plenty of value for horseplayers willing to take a stand. The wager kicks off with a maiden special weight that features several well-bred and lightly raced runners, making it a race where opinions will vary sharply. From there, bettors are treated to a mix of competitive allowance events and a deep turf sprint that could produce a price. While there is no graded stakes race anchoring the sequence, the overall difficulty level remains high, with several races lacking a clear standout. The key to the entire wager may be the middle leg of the sequence, where a large field and multiple pace scenarios create the potential for chaos. The closing races are equally tricky, particularly the turf dash, where trips and racing luck often play a major role over the Del Mar lawn. Handicappers who can survive the contentious early legs and uncover a price or two along the way could be rewarded with one of the better Late Pick 5 payouts of the meet.

Below are today's Price / Spot Plays. These are not usually the favorites, but horses we like that will provide some value (typically 5-2 or higher in general). The "Stars" rating is 1 – 5, with 5 being the MOST CONFIDENT / RECOMMENDED PLAYS.

If you remember correctly, I tipped out Janie Not Jeanie as a spot play opening weekend here at the seaside oval, and although she didn't win, the effort was encouraging enough for me to try her once again. She was highly regarded after her runner up finish to Pickupthatsgood, a talented McCarthy runner that we could potentially see in the Del Mar Debutante. Last time she decided she wanted to start hurdling down the backside, and was frankly one of the worst instances of climbing I've seen in some time. She lost a ton of ground because of it, but really rallied strongly in the late stages of that event. Now with the switch the to grass, she doesn't have to worry about getting anything thrown in her face, and draws an advantageous inside post with the rails way out today. A lot of attention will most likely go to the stablemate, and deservedly so based on her last effort, but take a long look at



Janie Not Jeanie to strike a mild upset.

Jack Fish is a horse I've always had an affinity for, especially based off his two efforts here last summer. He just got run down by an older rival for Carla Gaines in start number two, then graduated next time out, and when you look at the figures, they're right there with the rest of this group. I think you can forgive his last two efforts (one in dirt, other going long), and he's still even a candidate to take a step forward from 3 to 4. The blinkers come off today, which could put him nestled in behind the speed of the 2 and 8. If you see him in that position early on, he's extremely dangerous.

THIS IS MY PLAY OF THE DAY AT DEL MAR!!! First and foremost, the favorite Howie's Law can absolutely win, but is he really going to give an effort close to the 99 beyer we saw from him last time. In my opinion, that race came as a big surprise to the connections, otherwise he wouldn't have been in for the 50k tag. I was really impressed by how big Got'm Cot'm ran earlier on in the meet. To tell you the truth, there was more that I like from the ride Rosario gave last time rather than didn't like. He had him much more into the race than what we had seen previously, which I thought was great, but he found himself in this inside pressing trip, which is not a winning formula no matter where you run or how good you are. If I'm nit picking, he made Aqra blitz to take the lead around the far turn which was probably a bit premature, and ultimately dea in theq final stages, because he was up for the fight against Bazookie Charlie, who just got by him late. Those two were well wclear of the rest, and I thought Got'm Cot'm ran absolutely massive in that spot. He draws the re rail again, and if it were up to me, I'd love to see Rosario show that same aggression he did last time, but take back just a bit and sit the pocket. Hope I'm not asking too much from him.

So I'll take a shot with the firster who yes, has to overcome the outside post, but may have enough talent to do so, and will be a fair price because of it.
