- III. Guest Speaker (30mins): Michael Wynne from BHCare

Michael has worked with BHCare for over 30 yrs, starting in the Derby Parent Child Resource Center and is now in the Development Dept, dealing with grants, compliance and outreach. BHCares offers mental and behavioral health services, starting as young as 2yo and continuing through life. Adult care works with CT Dept. of Mental Health and Addiction Services, youth care works with CT Dept. of Children and Families.

Fast Facts: Service area runs along the shoreline, from Shelton, New Haven, to Madison.

- -311 employees
- -15,000 clients a year: 3,000 adults, 500 children
- -6,000 clients in domestic violence program (include 24/7 crisis help line)
- -4,500 clients in court-based advocacy programs in Milford, New Haven and Branford. (DV victims and clients with mental illness, meeting at the courthouse, advice, counseling, connect to other services like emergency shelters), and Jail diversion programs (1st&2nd offences, clients with mental health and substance abuse issues
- -5,000 clients in Alliance for Prevention and Wellness (APW) program (in schools, trainings for adults and community members, first responders, teachers, Narcan training)

Other Programs:

- -Umbrella Center for Domestic Violence and Victim Advocacy (safe houses, counselors, resources, developed Lethality Assessment used by first responders to assess a situation, and can call hotline for support, about 600 calls/year.
- -Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (consultation program can go to daycares, Head Start programs, schools for child and parent support) in 2024, 500 children served. Social Emotional learning in school has helped reduce need.
- -Adolescent Services (counciling, Intensive Outpatient Program, anxiety, depression, grief, risky behaviors) Parent Child Resource Center in Derby and North Branford
- -Adult Services (counseling, case management, housing and employment assistance, resume help and job shadowing, money management and legal help) Social Club for clients with chronic, severe mental illness
- -new building in North Branford! Primary Care on site through Fair Haven Community Health Care. Currently lobbying to get on the public transportation routes.
- -Intensive Outpatient Programs: (Behavior Skills Training, Symptom Management, Dual Diagnosis w/substance abuse, Work-Life Balance programs for first responses and professions)
- -BHCares does not charge for services, but does collect insurance information. Funded by a combination of state, federal programs, insurance, and independent fundraising.
