  - A. Outreach Committee -April Report, 4/27/25, Heather and Darleen:
  - The committee did not meet in April
  - On April 4th, Heather, along with EH Pride volunteers Paul and Sarah, presented a short talk to the cast and crew of EHHS play, The Prom. The director requested that we give a short talk re: who we are, what we do, and why The Prom and its message matters. It was a pleasure to talk with the students and to thank them for their work!
  - On April 5th, Heather and Jessica staffed the EH Pride table at The Prom. The table had a lot of interest from students and some family members; the rubber bracelets and pins were a big hit, as was Cindy's homemade popcorn bags! One student asked about LGBTQ pride flags we had on display; it might be a good idea to look into getting all of the different flags and having some on hand to give away; this student was looking for the Aro-Ace flag.
  - ETV is happy to host our Queer Coffee House in June. Connor said that they would be happy to hold just a social event if that was what we wanted, but they are also happy to do something like an open mic event alongside the Coffee House, etc. If anyone has any ideas in regards to our June Coffee House event, please share. Also it may be good to send out a poll or survey for this event to see what everyone would like for it.
  - My friends have a queer run business here in East Haven. It's called Queerly Departed and
    they sell pins, stickers, etc. At last month's meeting we mentioned a little Goodie Bag type
    of item for the people who attend the Ride with Pride event on May 4th. They were happy to
    provide something for the bags. I will be talking to them tomorrow (Monday) about this to
    get an update on where they are with that.
  - Darleen is in email contact with the manager at Witch Bitch Thrift Store and is trying to coordinate a meet up to discuss future partnership options. In the meantime, the store is happy to post our flyers and promote any happenings that we have, including Ride with Pride, Prism Book Club and other events hosted by the library.
  - Darleen attended April's Prism Book Club, which read and discussed Joy Landin's book of poems titled *Family*. Themes revolved around Joy's experience of losing her mother to illness, being seen/not seen or accepted by her mother and her children (Joy is a transwoman), what the concept of "family" means and how it can cross beyond bloodlines into "chosen" family (non-biological connections that are equally powerful).
