

Robson Ranch AZ Republican Club Bylaws

(approved 12/12/2023)

ARTICLE I. NAME

Section 1: The name of the Club shall be the Robson Ranch AZ Republican Club (RRAZRC).

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

Section 1: The purpose of the club shall be to advance the goals of the Republican Party and its candidates.

ARTICLE III. AUTHORITY AND LIMITATIONS

Section 1: The RRAZ Republican Club will operate in compliance with the bylaws and regulations of the HOA.

ARTICLE IV. MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Membership shall be limited to all Robson Ranch, Arizona, residents and shall not discriminate by race, religion, creed, or sexual orientation.

Section 2: For the purpose of this document, a “member in good standing” is a current resident of Robson Ranch and is current with their membership dues.

Section 3: Annual dues shall be recommended by the Board of Directors and approved by the membership.

Section 4: The fiscal year shall be from January 1st to December 31st.

Section 5: Annual dues shall be payable by the January meeting and shall be considered delinquent if not paid by the March meeting.

Section 6: Visitors may attend two meetings before membership is required.

ARTICLE V. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1: The Board of Directors shall consist of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and one Member-at-Large.

Section 2: The Board may delegate authority to committees or to the individual Directors as it deems necessary for the purpose of carrying out the business of the RRAZRC.

Section 3: Notice of regular and special meetings of the Board shall be sent to all Board members by the President or Secretary either by text, or email. Included with the notice shall be the proposed agenda.

Section 4: All Directors shall have a term of two years, beginning January 1st. The President and Treasurer shall be elected to serve in odd years and the Vice President, Secretary, and Member-at-large shall be elected to serve in

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even years. In the event the President's seat becomes vacant, the Vice President shall fill the position for the remainder of the elected term.

- Section 5: All other vacancies shall be filled by the Board until the next annual meeting.
- Section 6: A Board member may be removed by a majority vote of the Board.

ARTICLE VI. NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS

- Section 1: The Board shall appoint an Election Committee and the Election Committee shall solicit from the members in good standing a slate of potential candidates one month prior to the annual meeting.
- Section 2: The slate of officers proposed by the Election Committee shall be posted at least two weeks prior to the election meeting. Postings will be emailed to all members in good standing.

ARTICLE VII. DUTIES OF THE DIRECTORS

- Section 1: President – Shall be the chief administrator of the club and shall preside over all meetings. The President shall schedule facilities usage with the designated HOA representative. Contracts shall be signed by the President with approval from the RRAZRC Board.
- Section 2: Vice President – Shall assist the President and shall, in the President's absence, perform the duties of the office.
- Section 3: Secretary – The Secretary shall:
- a. Record the minutes of the Regular and Special meetings of the Board and membership.
 - b. Be in charge of all records of the club, other than the Treasurer's Report.
 - c. Be responsible for correspondence as required by the Board.
 - d. Make available any reports required by Robson Ranch AZ HOA, and
 - e. Coordinate with the Treasurer to keep a current record of membership names and email addresses.
- Section 4: Treasurer – The Treasurer shall:
- a. Be responsible for collecting the annual dues of the members and other monies as required.
 - b. Pay all bills owed by the club and
 - c. Present a financial report to the Board or membership monthly.
- Section 5: Member-at-large – Shall be selected by the Board from among members in good standing and will oversee committees as requested by the Board.

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ARTICLE VIII. MEETINGS

- Section 1: General meetings are open to all Robson Ranch, Arizona, residents unless otherwise noticed in advance and will be held the second Saturday of the month at a time and place as announced or as otherwise noticed.
- Section 2: The annual meeting will be held on the second Saturday of December unless otherwise noticed in advance at Robson Ranch, Arizona. At this meeting the election of the Board members for the year beginning January 1 will be held.
- Section 3: All members in good standing and present at any regular or special meetings of the Club shall be entitled to vote and to participate in all Club events.
- Section 4: Any person attending a meeting and making statements which disrupt, disturb or impede the orderly conduct of the meeting, or who lacks civility will be asked to leave, or shall be removed from said meeting by the President's designee. The Board, by majority vote, may revoke the membership of any member who violates this section.
- Section 5: Notices of all regular or special meetings shall be sent out not less than two weeks prior to the meeting.
- Section 6: All meetings will be held at Robson Ranch AZ unless otherwise noticed.

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENTS

- Section 1: These bylaws may be modified by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members in good standing who are present at a regular meeting or annual meeting. Notices shall be posted two weeks prior to the meeting and sent via email to all the members.

ARTICLE X. ENDORSEMENTS

- Section 1: The RRAZRC shall not endorse any Republican nominee or candidate for public office prior to the primary election. The RRAZRC may endorse or support any position on any issue, provided such endorsement falls within the function and purpose of the organization and its members.
- Section 2: All endorsements shall require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members in good standing who are in attendance at a regular meeting or annual meeting. Written notice shall be sent to all members via email two weeks prior to the meeting.

ARTICLE XI. DISSOLUTION

- Section 1: If dissolution is contemplated, the membership must be notified by email or letter at least two weeks in advance of the meeting date and time and the decision to dissolve must be made by vote with the concurrence of a

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simple majority of members in good standing in attendance at said meeting.

- Section 2: Dissolution will not be initiated until all outstanding debts are satisfied. A majority of the Board may direct the use of all assets to satisfy outstanding debts provided the majority of the membership (as prescribed in Section XI.1) has voted to dissolve this organization.
- Section 3: In the event of dissolution of this organization, all remaining assets will be donated to a similar club or a 501(c)(3) organization.
