Lazy River Playground Unveils Certified Forest Therapy Trail in Hermon



HERMON, N.Y. — Lazy River Playground and Retreat Center officially opened its Association of Nature and Forest Therapy (ANFT) certified trail on Saturday, May 16, marking the debut of a premier wellness destination in the North Country.

The grand opening ceremony, hosted by the St. Lawrence County Chamber of Commerce, attracted about 30 people and included a ribbon-cutting and a guided introduction to "forest bathing" stations—a research-based framework inspired by the Japanese practice of Shinrin-yoku designed to support health and wellness through immersion in nature.

Pickard, who spent 20 years in education and five years practicing Reiki at the Center for Cancer Care at CPH, noted that the trail's certification allows the facility to share the "magic" of the landscape with a broader community seeking rest and renewal. "What is happening at Lazy

River is truly inspirational," said Ben Dixon, executive director of the St. Lawrence County Chamber of Commerce. "They are taking a beloved local landmark with roots stretching back to 1942 and evolving it into a modern sanctuary. Integrating certified healing practices into the trail, gardens, and cabins dramatically elevates the value this property brings to St. Lawrence County. This development creates a premier wellness destination that will attract visitors from across the region while serving as a vital health and renewal resource for our own residents."

The trail is the result of a rigorous international certification process. The opening also launches Lazy River Forest Therapy, which will feature monthly guided walks and specialized wellness retreats, including "Reconnecting to Life" for grief support and "The Thrive! Retreat" for those healing from cancer.

The event also highlighted community collaboration, including a new Wellness Garden planned by Sarah Manning from Wildcraft Farms. Following the ceremony, attendees were invited to explore the grounds, which include waterfront access, a historic picnic pavilion, and guest cabins.

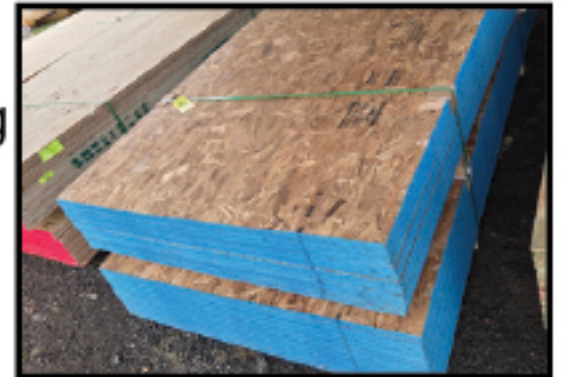
