⁶ Lunch at P10 and am and pm snacks at P5. P15 per day x number of school days per month plus Saturday activity days.

⁷ Distributed monthly (and/or quarterly) depending on the need of the student.

⁸ Consist mainly of regular non-prescription medicines (for head, tooth, stomach aches, coughs and colds, dizziness, lbn, etc.)

⁹ Based on local rate (in Zamboanguita boarding house rates range from P50 to P150 depending on the distance from the school and amenities like water)

¹⁰ For students who live in the respective lumad scholars' dormitory. Breakfast and dinner only. Dormers' lunch and snacks are deducted (i.e, P45 per day x 30 days x 10 months = P13,500 less P3,500).

¹¹ Grade 10 and Grade 12 Annual Retreats. Or School excursion/field trip for other grade levels. (Or college entrance testing fee, where applicable). A good pair of leather shoes cost about P300 to P500.
